# From the Administrator's Desk

Thanksgiving is always one of my favorite holidays. This probably goes back to the days when I was in my high school band as the culmination of the marching band season was the traditional Thanksgiving football game versus our rival Passaic. In Clifton, the Marching Band was almost a religion, nothing could be done other than band between August and Turkey Day. "The Showband of the Northeast" had band camp in the summer and then regular practices daily that would often be between 2 and 4 hours each day. Through those countless hours we developed strong relationships that still stay with me today. Even though we would perform a different show for every home game, Thanksgiving was special, we welcomed back any alum that played in the band to come back and perform with the current band on the field. We had people from the 1930's marching with us in kids in the 90's and it culminated with all of us playing our band song since the 70's "What I did for Love," from A Chorus Line. As an alum we would typically have practice the Wednesday before as Mr. Morgan, our band director, got caught up with all the news of our lives and then we would go out to celebrate and reminisce some more in a local establishment. We added to those traditions by meeting up for breakfast before the game at IHOP of all places (like we weren't going to eat enough later that day) and we still do many of them almost 30 years later. What I remember most, what I am most thankful for, is the love of friendship and family that was passed on then and continues today. A waitress once teared up and said "I want a tradition like that!" to which I replied "so, make one!" It's not rocket science, if you care for someone make time for them, say yes and give of yourself. Often we ask a lot of God, how often do we go back to say thank you? But it is more than just giving thanks, it is also asking ourselves how we might be able to use those gifts that we are thankful for to continue to build up Christ's Kingdom on Earth. Our band song reminds us: "Love is never gone... as we travel on, love's what we'll remember." As we give thanks for the love we have received, let us never forget to give it as well.

## Saint Cecilia | November 22

Saint Cecilia's story, like many of the earliest saints, is largely apocryphal and legendary in nature. According to tradition, Cecilia was born to a wealthy and prominent Roman family. Though she had consecrated her virginity to the Lord, she was married to a man named Valerian. It is said that she was "singing in her heart to the Lord" at her wedding. She confessed her promise of virginity to her new husband revealing that an angel protected her. Valerian would honor her vow only if he too could see the angel. Cecilia told him he would see the angel if he was baptized, which he went to do immediately. When he returned to her, he saw the angel beside her. Cecilia also converted Valerian's brother, Tiburtius.

Unfortunately, it was a turbulent time in Rome for Christians. Valerian and Tiburtius were martyred for burying the bodies of Christians, which was illegal. Cecilia was also targeted for her faith. First authorities attempted to suffocate by locking her in the bath in her home and overheating the room. Some accounts say that she didn't break a sweat and even began to sing. They then sent in an executioner to behead her, but he faltered and was unable to complete his task, only succeeding in mortally wounding her. She remained alive for three days before she died. The saint's body was exhumed twice, first by Pope Paschal I in 821, then by Cardinal Sfondrato in 1599. Both times her body was found incorrupt, the first saint to exhibit this extremity. St. Cecilia is the patron saint of music and musicians.

## THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays, 1:15 pm. Expectant and adoptive parents are required to attend our Baptism Preparation class (Godparents are invited). These are held on the First Friday of each month at 7:30 pm; pre-registration is required. We suggest calling the parish office at least 3 months prior to your child's scheduled birth, or in the case of adoption, upon completion of the adoption process. Contact the Parish Office at 735-7319 for all arrangements and before the selection of Godparents.

## THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements with the Parish Office should be made at least one year in advance to the desired date and before any social plans are finalized. The Common Policy for the Dioceses of New Jersey requires a period of preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the parish priest or deacon and participation the Diocesan Pre-Cana program.

## FOR THE SICK OR HOMEBOUND

For those unable to physically come to Mass, we encourage you to call the Parish Office to make arrangements for the Eucharist to be brought to you or for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Catholic Chaplains are assigned by the Diocese of Metuchen for patients in Hunterdon Medical Center, but we will gladly visit as well if asked and our parish is responsible for Rolling Hills Nursing Care Facility. In cases of emergencies, call the parish office, if after hours, a priest is on call.

## **PARISH REGISTRATION**

If you are a current and/or new parishioner and have moved or changed phone numbers, please contact the parish office. To enable us to better serve you all parishioners must be registered. Family members 18 years or older should register as an individual. You must be a registered (and active) parishioner to be a Confirmation or Baptism Sponsor.

There are two main reasons we encourage parishioners to use envelopes or enroll in Faith Direct (see below). The primary reason we utilize the envelope system is so we can produce End of Year statements for parishioners for income tax purposes. Secondarily, because of the large size of our parish, this system allows us to track, although imperfectly, the regularity of attendance. Since we cannot possibly know each individual personally, this system is used to assist the administrator when someone requests a sponsorship letter for Baptism/Confirmation. The sponsorship letter requires the pastor to attest to the fact that the sponsor fulfills their obligation as a Catholic by participating in the sacramental life of the Church, our Sunday Mass obligation. So please, utilize our envelopes, even if you are unable to donate financially, since we can verify regular participation should they not be familiar to us.


