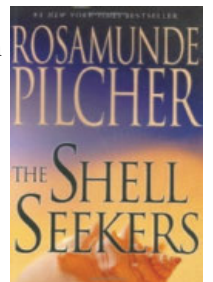

### From the Administrator's Desk

It's been an interesting week here on St. Mary's Hill! We had an excellent first Coffee with Clergy event and I hope you join me this week as we discuss the Eucharist. We finally got some snow but were also blinded last "Sun-Day" at 5 PM Mass when the window shade broke in the Church. Then I was approached by some concerned parishioners stating that their Bishop's Annual Appeal letter came from St. Joseph's in Carteret instead of Immaculate Conception (Msgr. John Gordon is pretty awesome though). FYI, we immediately contacted the diocese and anyone who was effected should have gotten the corrected pledge card in the mail or it should be coming shortly. I apologize for the error and thank all who had reached out to tell us, it was a great help! We all make mistakes, but it is so embarrassing when we realize them.

I should know, I made a personal one earlier this week... I hurt someone I care about a great deal by how I said something, it was not my intent, but it happened and I was to blame. Although it was forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, I still was left with a terrible feeling in the pit of my stomach and lost many hours of sleep over it. We go over these things in our minds on how we can do things better and sometimes we know, but sometimes we aren't so sure. I know I am not alone in feeling this way. While I was comforted so many times in praying the Liturgy of the Hours this week and in celebrating Mass, I also felt terrible that, as a servant of Christ, I may have led someone away from God. God reminded me that He was still working with me and helped me to empathize with the person I hurt. During Lent, I always utilize the Confiteor in the Penitential Rite, and reminded you last week that we should pray for forgiveness not only for the sinful things we do, but for the good and holy things we fail to do. Just like we do in that prayer, I asked other people to pray for me, I spent some time with my good friends, the Saints and lit a candle to our Blessed Mother to ask for her intercession.

There is a line in Luke's version of the Transfiguration (we hear from Matthew today), in which it says about Peter: "But he did not know what he was saying." That line resonates with me as even when I feel I am standing in God's presence, the cluelessness of my sinfulness sometimes gets the best of me. I have told many of you when someone compliments a homily: "It is all God's work, unless it's terrible, then it was mine." It's at these moments in our life, when we fail, that we can simply pray the words of today's responsorial Psalm: "Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you." Remember that he forgives us and asks us to start again or as it says in Timothy: "He saved us and called us to a holy life, not according to our works but according to his own design." Let us simply have faith in Him!
