From the Administrator's Des

Yesterday, March 25, was the Feast of the Annunciation, which of course means that there are only 9 months left until Christmas! One of my favorite paintings of the Annunciation is by Henry Ossawa Tanner and can be found on the last page of the bulletin since I could expand it to where you can actually see it (it can also be viewed at the Philadelphia Museum of Art). I love it because so often we have images of our Blessed Mother that look so perfect, which she most definitely is, but Tanner's approach, I find to be much more realistic. She is a normal young girl of the time, looking like she just got out of bed and is confounded with this amorphous being giving her a message of her impending pregnancy. Subtly, what she is to become is represented by the blue garment that is draped to the side of the painting. I connected with this piece, since so often we think of the saints' perfection as something that is unattainable in our imperfect lives. Yet, we hear in Luke's Gospel, Mary had questions, she was afraid and troubled, she wasn't sure like so many of us.

Martha and Mary, the sisters of Lazarus (not to be confused with the Blessed Mother) in today's Gospel, also are a bit angry with Jesus, claiming that if he were present Lazarus would not have died. While they do say the right things when Jesus asks questions, there is also a bit of lack of faith. How often do we say the right thing, but don't really believe it? It can be so difficult for our finite minds to grasp the infinite and some will argue that we cannot, so why try. However, my brothers and sisters, we are merely on a journey, we are not at the conclusion yet and what we are to become has not been fully revealed to us. Therefore, a lack of understanding, confusion and frustration is to be expected. Our Lord doesn't expect us to grasp everything, but challenges us to ponder the possibilities and witness the glimpses of that perfect reality that he has presented and promised awaits all who believe and follow him.

In one aspect we have a very human Jesus: he cries, he is perturbed more than once and he is troubled, yet he in Christ's divinity he also raises Lazarus from the dead. There are so many questions in the Catholic faith where the Church's response is "both/and" and we see it witnessed here, where Christ is human and divine and there have been many heresies that try to deny one of those aspects of Christ. Instead of trying to make it easier and failing, enter into the mystery, ask questions and seek to truly understand the faith that we proclaim, you won't be disappointed!






