From the Administrator's Dest

Last week, I took the opportunity to go out with Fr. Mike for dinner and then go to see the St. Thomas Aquinas Drama Department's rendition of Legally Blonde, which was a nice evening and a fantastic performance as always. What struck me that evening though, was how much some of my former students' appearances had changed over just a short time. It was somewhat startling and I guess that when you see them day after day the gradual transition from teen to young adult is muted; here it was quite pronounced. I thought about that in regards to our own Lenten journeys, perhaps we cannot see how those changes have had an influence in our life since we have lived them each and every day, but would someone who hasn't seen you in a while think that you have become closer to God? After all, that is the goal and I encourage you to take those things that you took on or gave up during Lent to accomplish that grown and continue them now that you have done it for almost 40 days.

As we enter into this holiest time of the year for us as Catholics, I invite you to pause and take some quiet time for yourself to truly enter into this Holy Week. These unique liturgies are only celebrated one time a year, and just like Jesus, in today's Gospel message from Matthew, invites the disciples into the Garden of Gethsemane to stay watch with Him as he prays, He invites us into this silent moment of reflection on the Eucharist on Holy Thursday, His willingness to die for us on Good Friday and the feeling of emptiness on Holy Saturday before the Celebration of His resurrection. Let us pray for each other that both our Spirit and our flesh may be strong enough to persevere through the struggles of the busyness of our lives.

In addition to our normal offerings during the Triduum, we will be transforming the Parish Hall into our Altar of Repose on Holy Thursday and will be closing the night of prayer with our Lord in

having a Sunrise Service on Easter in the Cemetery (bring your own chair and blanket), if it rains we will move into the Mausoleum, either way it will be held at 6 AM. Finally, starting Holy Thursday, I am pleased to announce that we will be bringing back the Precious Blood at the front of the Church for those who would like to receive. I had gotten a number of requests and with the CDC announcing the end of the public health emergency, I thought it was time to bring it up to the clergy and Pastoral Council and we will see how it goes moving forward. We will need more

Eucharistic Ministers to assist and will still be diligent in maintaining a healthy approach to serving you; no one should feel obligated to receive as Christ's Body and Blood is fully present under both species according to Catholic belief. I hope you all have a Holy Week and continue to strive to be closer to Christ.


