



### From the Pastor's Desk

"I am the Good Shepherd says the Lord; I know my sheep and mine know me." *John 10:14* It's not often that the Scripture quote of the week that inspires me is from the Alleluia verse... but on this Good Shepherd Sunday, it could not be more appropriate. Why are we followers of the Lord? Because we have heard his voice call to us and we recognize that voice that has earned our trust.

Pope St. John Paul II wrote the Apostolic Exhortation Pastores Dabo Vobis (I will give you Shepherds) back in 1992 which was the document that serves as the foundation of Seminary Formation of priests in the current day. During the month of May many of my brother priests will be celebrating their anniversary of priesthood and between my getting ready to be installed by the bishop as your pastor next week and my predecessor's celebration of his 25th Anniversary of priesthood coming up, the idea of being a good shepherd formed in the image of our Lord really was a point of reflection this week. Pastores Dabo Vobis reminds us that there are four pillars of formation for the priesthood: Intellectual, Spiritual, Human and Pastoral and seminaries often challenge the men entrusted to their care to grow in all aspects of their formation because each is important. Someone missing the spiritual component might listen to that stranger that Christ is talking about in today's Gospel, he might be led to believe that he or she is the savior, not Jesus. We see many of the failings of the intellectual component of our faith life if we simply watch how many news stories or non-Catholics portray Catholic beliefs and lead Catholics to not understand their own faith. Human formation, Pastores Dabo Vobis states is "the basis of all priestly formation" (43), it helps us to relate to others and to develop healthy relationships. Finally, Pastoral formation, as an engineer, this one appealed to me the most, how does one take the intellectual, spiritual and human knowledge and apply it to real life. One can have all the right knowledge and be in communion with our Lord and still choose to apply it in a way that drives people away from the Church and the Lord. While this was written for the formation of priests, it is also a great read for all of us, since we are all called to not only follow the Good Shepherd, but to also imitate Him as well.

In a few weeks we will be ordaining another seminarian who has spent time in our parish during the summer, we had an influence on his life and so many others through their summer assignments here. How do we help them to know Christ and to grow intellectually, spiritually, humanly and pastorally while they were here? How do we do it ourselves? Jesus is the good shepherd, we know Him and try to become more like Him as we lead others to know Him as well.


### SILVER & GOLD WEDDING ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION




