

From the Pastor's Desk

I spent many hours in my mother's car with the station often tuned to WLTW, 106.7 Lite FM although once I got older I tried my best to switch the station to something "cooler." Then it happened... somewhere between my Freshman and Sophomore year of high school, a band on my station, did a cover of a song on my parent's... and I have to admit, it was nowhere near as good as the original. That song was Cats in the Cradle by Harry Chapin and later Ugly Kid Joe. The song tells about a relationship between Father and Son that I never experienced growing up, but it still struck a chord with me and apparently many others since it did get to #1 in 1974 and then to #6 in 1993. I am sure many of you are familiar with the song, but in case you aren't, it tells the story of a Father and a Son, the latter always stating that "I'm going to be like you, Dad," even when the Father is too busy with "life" during the formative years to spend time with his son. It quickly moves to the boy growing up and actually following in his father's footsteps, being too busy with his "life" to spend time with his dad. What really stood out to me was not an anger or hatred for father or son, even the last verse says "I'd love to Dad if I can find the time... and it's been sure nice talking to you." I guess at a younger age it served as a warning of how not to live my life and not to take things for granted.

As we celebrate Father's Day, I am blessed that I did not have the experience of the young boy in the song, but unfortunately, I know many people who did. Especially as it comes to faith formation, I cannot emphasize enough the importance of a father who prays and goes to Mass in a young person's life. There was a study by the Swiss government (I would love to see an updated one, but I did not have an extensive time to research this); it showed the importance of the father regularly practicing the faith in the life of their children practicing the faith. Regardless of a mother's practice, a father's regular practice of the faith led to a child's regular practice of the faith over 33% of the time and almost always 70% of regular or irregular practice. Never underestimate the powerful witness you can be, in either direction, by your actions or inactions.

I believe this is also the importance of organizations like the Knights of Columbus, who happen to be doing a membership drive today! It is important that men are supported in their goal of being good Christian role models for their children and others. It was with this vision that Blessed Michael McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus when he noticed the desire of young men to want to be part of something bigger than themselves and to help those in need. It is what our Council still believes in and supports through their various works of charity and through the pamphlets on Fatherhood that they often put out, so consider joining. Let us pray for our fathers and father figures this day and try to be the best example possible for all of our children.
