

From the Pastor's Desk

At first glance of today's Gospel, my eyes played a cruel trick on me... I was reading about how Matthew tells us that "even all the hairs of your head are counted" and after I took a quick drink of water, mistakenly read the line above instead of the line below which states "and not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge." I laughed and thought well, at least that justifies the fact that I need a couple of days off!

It is the end of Matthew's Gospel that I would like to focus on though: "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others..." Our Lord says this, yet we still become very uncomfortable with acknowledging our Lord in front of others. I remember a story that I once read about a missionary who spoke about a time before the fall of the Soviet Union when Christians were often forced to pray in secret because practice of faith was forbidden. On one occasion there was a knock on the door of some gathered in a house to study the Bible together and when they didn't answer, three Soviet soldiers with rifles entered the house and announced that anyone who was not Christian were free to leave, but those who called themselves Christians should remain. The worshippers were scared and most fled, but a few brave souls decided to stay. One of the soldiers closed the door and locked it. They sat down with the remaining worshippers and explained that they too were Christians and wanted to pray with true believers. ("A Faith Test" author unknown; Our Catholic Faith).

When I first read the story, I thought I knew how it was going to turn out and similarly, especially before I was a priest, there have been times that I didn't want to say something because I thought I knew how it would turn out. Often times, I was surprised that these little tests of faith, if I found the courage to stand up for it, strengthened mine as well. Our Lord doesn't want us to hide our faith, he tells us to fear no one and to not worry about the one who can harm the body, but not the soul. When we hear good news we want to tell everyone, we sometimes even shout it out loud, you can see it in our faces and hear it in our voice that something good has happened - we fell in love, we did a great job or won a prize, or maybe our favorite sports team did something great. So then why are we ashamed to share the Good News, that the Gates of Heaven are open to us and we can be united with our God once again? Let our prayer today be our Responsorial Psalm: "Lord in your great love, answer me" and then have faith that the Holy Spirit will provide us all that we need when we are too nervous or scared.




