From the Pastor's Desk

The First Reading today from the 1st Book of Kings is one of my favorite readings in the Old Testament. Elijah is told on his journey that the Lord will pass by while He is on Mount Horeb (St. Jerome and others posit that Horeb and Sinai are synonymous). So the person we should naturally think about as well is Moses. Moses, as he lead the people of Israel out of slavery and gave the Law of God to them, witnesses God in great natural occurrences: a pillar of fire, a strong wind that split the Red Sea, an earthquake and thunder upon Mount Sinai. Yet, as Elijah experiences these things on the same mountain, the Lord does not show Himself in that way, but only in the stillness and silence. Last week, in the Transfiguration, Jesus is greeted by Moses and Elijah; today we see that God calls each of us, how He does it may not always be the same.

As I have just come off retreat that silence of God and the attentive listening really stood out. As you can see, we prayed a lot, and although I have visited the monks before, I am always amazed at how unnatural the timing of their prayer is to me and others when I first get there. We all tend to rush things and the pause in their prayer made me think about Elijah's listening. Even within our work or prayer, we need to pause to hear where the Lord might be guiding us. It's funny that the more time I spent with the monks the more natural their cadence seemed to be (and how quickly I'd notice the next new visitor come in &

try to fill the silence with the next line as I did a few days earlier).

We don't live on the mountain tops though, we need to come back down, Moses and Elijah did as well. However, just like last week, we can be forever changed by our experiences as we try our best to witness how God is working in our lives right here and now. Even if we become frightened and start to sink in our faith life, as Peter did, our Lord will always be there to save us. He'll remind us of His presence if we only take the time to listen.




PRIEST PERSONNEL ANNOUNCEMENTS

Bishop Checchio has made the following appointments of Deans:

- Very Rev. Thomas Serafin is appointed Dean of the Round Valley Deanery (replacing the retiring Fr. Rusk) (Immaculate Conception is part of the Round Valley Deanery)
- Very Rev. Michael Gromadzki is appointed Dean of the Raritan Bay Deanery (replacing the retiring Fr. Weezorak)
- Very Rev. Charles Sabella is appointed Dean of the Morris Canal Deanery (replacing Fr. Selvester who is moving)

What is a Dean?

Deans have an overall role to promoting collaboration among the priests and parishes of their deanery. A Dean should be aware of the special needs of the priests and people of his deanery. He should call the priests together for prayer, fellowship and discussion of pastoral matters. He should foster pastoral collaboration for initiatives better done by parishes working and planning together in their common mission of evangelization. He might be called on to participate with the Bishop in formal parish pastoral visitations (such as listening sessions in the search for a new pastor). He must review annually the sacramental records of each parish in his deanery and attest to their accuracy by his signature in the sacramental registers. He should visit and support the priests of his deanery during times of illness, and to advise the Bishop of serious illness or hospitalization among the priests. He may, if requested, assist in coordinating the funeral arrangements upon the death of a priest.
