



# From the Pastor's Desk

I went to get a new cell phone this past week and one of the things that I always am paranoid about is losing the information that I have stored on my phone. I go through a process of what I refer to as "backing up my life" just in case something goes wonky and the cell phone company completely erases everything. I feel powerless and worry that it will be too late before I recognize that I am missing something and it does not feel good.

I think the woman in today's Gospel message understands that feeling of being completely powerless as she begs Jesus for help for her daughter. I am sure she actually felt that way well before Jesus came by; I am not sure how many of us would feel otherwise if our child was being tormented by a demon. She still reaches out for Jesus and asks for the Lord to have pity on her. Yet, He remains silent and the disciples become frustrated with her bothering them. How quickly we forget that just last week, Peter and the disciples were the ones begging Jesus to save them! It makes me wonder about how we pray and then treat others in our life who ask for the same things that we seek.

It's funny that I worry so much when someone else has control of my phone, but when it is just me living my day-to-day life, I rarely, if ever back it up in case I do something wrong. I also realize that the one time I did lose a whole bunch of pictures and files in my life was because I dropped my phone and didn't have a backup. Our Lord challenges us today to not see our faith in Him as something that is only for us or a select few. We are part of something much bigger than ourselves... all of us need to be rescued from our sins and Christ wants each of His sons and daughters to receive that mercy. Even if my phone loses all my contacts and I forget how to contact God, He will never lose my number & will reach out reminding me I have nothing to fear; He is there for all of us whenever we need Him.




