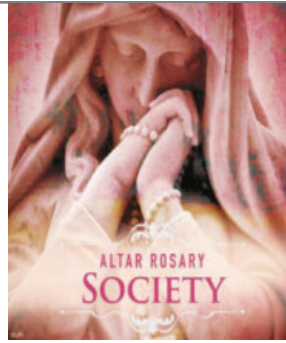

From the Pastor's Desk



Jesus asks his disciples a pertinent question today, "but who do *you* say that I am?" Although each of us has come to worship our God together today, we might be surprised that even believers may answer quite differently when we are asked to describe Jesus. Is He a comforter, a gift giver, a judge, a teacher, a fortune teller, a miracle worker, the ideal human or a myriad of other possibilities to us? Each of us comes with a certain point of view and we almost always are lacking the complete view of Jesus. Peter states that He is the Christ, or Messiah, the one who saves us and is the fulfillment of the promise of God the Father. He is commended that he did not learn this from another human being, but from listening to God himself. While all those other roles can be attributed to Jesus in some way, this is His primary function, to save us from our sins.

Matthew writes (as does Mark and Luke in their versions of the story) that Jesus ordered the disciples not to tell anyone. This may seem odd to us, but during the time of the apostles many people had a specific belief of what it meant to be the Messiah and usually were worried more about earthly things than being saved from sin and granted eternal life. Are we any different? Jesus wanted people to listen for themselves and make a decision to put their faith in Him based on what He said and did. While we might at first be interested in someone or something because we heard it from someone else, we ultimately have to make the decision to listen on our own.

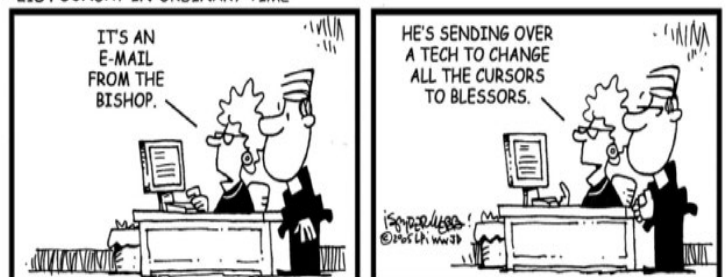

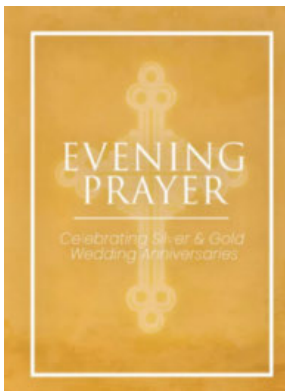

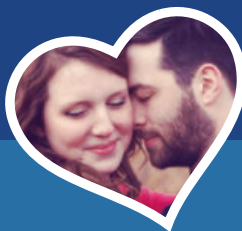
