#### WELCOME BACK HOME, FR. EDGAR!

Fr. Edgar Madarang was born and raised in the

Philippines. The youngest of eight, he has four sisters, and three brothers. He obtained a

Bachelor's degree in

Mathematics with a major in Computer Science from the Ateneo de Manila University.



He came to the United States in 1993 to pursue a career in information technology.

Fr. Edgar discovered his vocation later in life after he immersed himself in the life of his parish in Richmond, Virginia. He applied for priesthood and was assigned to complete his priestly formation at St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, MD. As a seminarian for the Diocese of Metuchen, he served at St. John the Evangelist in Dunellen, and in 2014 he was assigned to Holy Family Parish in New Brunswick for his pastoral year as a Transitional Deacon.

Fr. Edgar was ordained a Priest on May 23, 2015 by Bishop Paul Bootkoski who assigned him to Immaculate Conception for the first four years of his priesthood. Bishop Checchio re-assigned him to Immaculate Conception after serving at the Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi for four years.





### From the Pastor's Desk

"You duped me, O LORD, and I let myself be duped" from the prophet Jeremiah in today's first reading is one of my favorite lines to reflect upon in Scripture (and we have another opportunity to do it in the Liturgy of the Hours Office of Readings on the Beheading of John the Baptist this week!) Jeremiah feels betrayed because of the suffering he is undergoing and he even says "I will speak in his name no more." I just love the reality of how we feel at times when we are in the midst of difficulties, we may even say that we are done with it. Perhaps not with God, but definitely with other people, even people we love. Asking ourselves why do I subject myself to this? We may even think of running away.

It is the turn that I love the most in Jeremiah's text though... "But then it becomes like fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones; I grow weary holding it in, I cannot endure it." He feels the truth within him of the Lord's presence, he was merely fooling himself, he knows why he is called to do what he has to.

This week I was asked multiple times if I am ready for the kids to come back to school and I hope each time I said it with an emphatic: YES! I explained to a couple of parishioners that while it is more work, it is also so much more fulfilling to see why we do what we are called to do on a daily basis. It becomes less about administration and more about ministry, or at the very least it puts a face to the work of administration. It's the same as a mother or father who hasn't gotten sleep and has a crying child screaming at them but then pauses to just smile at them. Sure, we might be frustrated at times, maybe ask God "why me?" or say "I can't do this anymore," but in our hearts we know the truth as did Jeremiah. Despite the difficulties or added work, we know in our hearts where we are supposed to be and know the Lord is with us through it all.


