






The Altar Rosary Society will meet on **September 12**th at 6:30pm in Parish Hall for a social gathering and refreshments.



From the Pastor's Desk

Last week, the faculty and staff of St. Thomas Aguinas High School came to Immaculate Conception for a brief respite to focus on the school mission before the school year began. Fr. Anthony Sirianni, whom I had the pleasure of living with for five years in Edison was our keynote speaker. One of the things that Fr. Anthony asked us to do was to close our eyes and imagine ourselves walking and seeing someone we knew that we knew, but couldn't really see. Eventually as we caught up to the person, we realized it was us at a different age. After the experience, Fr. Anthony asked how many of us were surprised that the person wasn't Jesus (almost all of us by the way, myself included). I have thought about that a great deal since that day, a few weeks ago I asked you to ponder who you say Jesus is in your life. I wonder if our pre-conceived notions of others, including Jesus, make us either assume we know what he is going to say or just tune him out completely when we know it is a topic that is going to challenge us.


"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." Every day, our Lord gives us a message to help us grow, are we willing to hear it? Maybe our Lord uses others and even ourselves to help us when we have had a moment in which our hearts are hardened. There was a movie back in 2000 that touched upon a similar idea, Disney's The Kid and then a song by Brad Paisley from 2007 entitled A Letter to Me; often in school we have students write letters to themselves at various stages to show how they've grown or what they've conquered, but as we get older we don't really do those things. It's a good practice for us to get in touch with ourselves beyond the here and now. Our Lord sees us with the eyes of the past and the future, to see the potential brought to fulfillment that we might be blinded to see ourselves currently. We just need to not harden our hearts, to listen for where He is leading, because that is ultimately our mission.




