### **CATECHETICAL QUESTIONS**

### What is a pilgrimage? Why do people go on them?



A pilgrimage is a spiritual journey to visit a holy site, such as the shrine of a saint, a place where the Blessed Virgin Mary has appeared, or an historic church or chapel. What makes a pilgrimage different from a vacation and a pilgrim distinct from a tourist is the spirit in which the journey is made. Pilgrimages are really a symbol of our spiritual journey in life, reminding us that this world is not our true home and that we spend our lives journeying to our homeland, which is the Kingdom of God.

Pilgrimages - which can be as involved as a trip to Rome or the Holy Land or as simple as visiting the Blessed Sacrament in a local parish church - are also an opportunity for us to step out of the rhythms and limits of our daily lives to seek out connection with God in a special way, by visiting a holy place. At times, such as on a special feast, a jubilee, or the anniversary of the dedication of the church, special graces (called "indulgences") can also be offered to pilgrims, helping to enrich our experience of the celebration.

In the end, pilgrimages are an ancient act of devotion and something that each of us can put into practice, helping us to discover how God is present in the world around us, in places both near and far.

Please join us in welcoming our newest parishioners being baptized next weekend!

### From the Pastor's Desk

Did you know that there were 613 laws that practicing Jews were expected to follow? So today's question by the scholar of the law to Jesus can be likened to a student asking his or her teacher "What do I really need to know?" Jesus responds with four sentences that many of us have memorized: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." This is the greatest and the First Commandment. The Second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two Commandments." The first was the daily prayer of the Jewish people the Shema; they would have known this very well as they were required to say it daily. The second part Jesus takes from the Book of Leviticus - about halfway thorough (19:18), and one can easily miss the line since it is just in a list of rules of conduct. The next line is about breeding animals and not sowing a field with two kinds of seed. I think it is important that a line that can be looked over and thought of as insignificant has the same importance to Jesus as the very practical line that everyone knows.

Jesus makes it simple for us - love God and love our neighbor. Yet, as I would often tell my students, at the same time He made it very difficult for us. While following two things is simpler than following 613, there are things that are not listed as one of the 613 commandments that now we are deemed culpable of obeying. We cannot separate love of God and love of neighbor. Even the 10 Commandments is a list of sins against God & sins against man.

I am often asked: "Why do I need to confess my sins to a priest?" It is a great question and one that I will not answer fully here due to limited space. Yet the part I'd like us to reflect upon is that the priest stands "in persona Christi" (in the person of Christ) while also being a human being. In the Confessional, he represents both God and man, the same two things Jesus reminds us to love, if we truly want to follow Him. If I just confess my sins to God (which I do every night by the way), I am missing an important aspect of the faith. I also need to seek forgiveness for the sins from my neighbor. We believe that each one of us is made in the image of God, so let us not reject reconciliation with God just because we don't want to reconcile with our neighbor.




