THE CHURCH AND POLITICS

Fr. Keith was made aware of some individuals that were handing out political flyers last week after Mass at the bottom of our parking lot. These individuals did not ask permission nor were they given approval to hand out any flyers by Fr. Keith or anyone within Immaculate Conception Parish. While the Church can speak for and against issues that we advocate. we cannot and do not publicly favor any one specific candidate over another nor stand in opposition to any candidate for public office, regardless of personal views. We take this very seriously as it is a matter of law and our tax-exempt status.

Once this issue was brought to Fr. Keith's attention, he asked the individuals to step away from the property and they complied and he consulted our parish and diocesan lawyers. But we ask that if you are ever aware of someone canvassing our property to let the clergy or staff know as soon as possible, so that we may address it quickly. Please also note that we cannot control what is on the opposite side of our property. We thank those individuals who did let us know and apologize if anyone believed that this was a parish-sanctioned outreach.

CATECHETICAL QUESTIONS

If I go to the Sacrament of Penance, but end up repeating the same sins, does that mean I do not have a strong enough intention to amend my life?



There is a popular expression that says, "Be patient. God isn't finished with me yet!" Growing in faith and holiness is an ongoing, life-long project, and our struggle with sin is at the heart of it. As St. Paul says, the good he intends to do, he does not do. The evil he does not intend, he does! It is not always a lack of intention, but more the allure of evil that makes it difficult to change.

When we confess our sins, we are to come with a fully contrite heart. You need to reflect on your true feelings toward your actions before approaching the sacrament. After confession, there are strategies you can make to avoid falling into the same traps of sin. First, pray for and seek out strength and perseverance through multiple sacraments, charitable work, and personal sacrifice. Second, avoid occasions of sin when you might fail or be sorely tempted. In doing these things, remind yourself daily that it is a spiritual war we wage, and with God's grace, we will succeed.

I thought last weekend was going to be it... as I sat in the beautiful fall weather at Rutgers SHI Stadium, I couldn't believe that at halftime my beloved Scarlet Knights were leading the number one team in the country: THE Ohio State University. Especially as the third quarter began and RU was moving the ball down the field, I thought that they would grab a two score lead, but alas, it wasn't meant to be. It was not their time to score that big upset that Rutgers fans have been waiting for since they beat #2 USF in 2007. Yet, as I left the stadium, I felt that the time could be quite soon once again; that the sleeping giant can finally arise. I would be quite happy if Penn State found a way to beat Michigan this weekend (this was written before the game) only to lose to RU next weekend in Happy Valley, just saying.

This weekend's readings remind us about timing and being prepared for the coming of the Lord, but also of hope. 


