

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION





FR. EDGAR'S PILGRIMAGE



Among the spiritual activities that I relish in my ministry is leading a Pilgrimage to Holy Sites, especially Marian Shrines. I lead Pilgrimages that included visits to Fatima, Lourdes, and Guadalupe. This year I organized a Pilgrimage to three Eastern European Countries, highlighted by a visit in Medjugorje in Bosnia-Herzegovina, the Shrine of the Infant Jesus of Prague in Czechia, and the Shrines of Divine Mercy and Our Lady of Czestochowa in Poland.

Personally, I found our visit to Medjugorje the most impactful. Our Lady of Peace (the title the Blessed Mother gave the Seers) continues to appear, since her first apparition began on June 24, 1981, to six children, now adults, in the town of Medjugorje (meaning "Between Hills"), while it

was still part of communist Yugoslavia. Although The Vatican has not officially recognized this Marian shrine, pilgrimages have been authorized to Medjugorje since 2019 under the condition that there is no assumption the events are confirmed to have a supernatural origin.



Medjugorje turned into Europe's third most important apparition site, where each year

more than 1 million people visit. It has been estimated that 30 million pilgrims have come to Međjugorje since the reputed apparitions began.

If Lourdes is the Shrine associated with Healings, Fatima the Shrine for Praying, especially of the Rosary, Guadalupe for Evangelization, Medjugorje is known as the Shrine for Confessions. At the Shrine, one cannot help but feel a lot of Peace and find a lot of room to pray and reflect on God's Love and Mercy (maybe because of the kindness and piety of the locals, and also because the commercialization of the place has not taken over, or most likely because of the presence of Our Lady of Peace).

The mid-afternoon 45-minute climb of the Apparition Hill, where the Blessed Mother appeared to the children at the different areas of the Hill, though

challenging because of the incline and rocky terrain, was the climax for most, if not all, of the members in our group. Pilgrims climb the hill as a sign of penance and to be closer to God. At the top, besides the picture taking that occurred, our group capped our climb by praying four decades of the Rosary. We prayed the fifth at the bottom so that we could safely navigate down the hill before sunset.



In her message to the Seers, (still children then), Our Lady gave them five stones as their weapon against their Goliath (the Devil). These stones are: Prayer with the heart (Rosary), Eucharist, Holy Bible, Fasting and Monthly Confession.

Whether we are pilgrims or not I believe we all could use these stones against our Goliaths as we prepare to celebrate the Incarnation of Our Lord.

Just like the seers who were called by the Blessed Mother, we too felt and were reminded that our journey to Medjugorje was an invitation and a call from God's mother herself.

We came out spiritually refreshed and rejuvenated after Medjugorje. Thus, for most, if not all in our group, the visits to the other Shrines in Czechia, Krakow, and Warsaw were just the icing on the cake.



HAITI HOME BUILDING PROJECT

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ:

Next Weekend the First Sunday of Advent, we will begin our 18th Annual Haiti Home Building Project. Your generosity over the years on behalf of the people of Haiti has reduced the suffering and frustrations of the poor, and by doing so you have brought peace into their minds and into their hearts.

You have supported them with your selfless love and kindness. A stranger has reached out to them in their pain and has helped to heal their misery. You have remembered them from afar and you have refreshed their faith. They no longer feel invisible or forgotten by God.

For 18 years the parish community of Immaculate Conception has been supporting poor and homeless people of Haiti through the construction of clean, safe housing. To date your contributions of more than \$325,000 to our annual *Haiti Home Building Project* has enabled *Food for the Poor* to build 91 homes which are providing a safe, clean, warm place to live for more than 300 adults and children.

Additionally, because of your generosity we have purchased thousands of pounds of rice and beans, farm animals and fruit trees, school supplies, solar lamp kits, and water pumps, each of which provides and entire village with clean water for drinking, cleaning and personal hygiene. We also helped fund the construction of a new school in the town of Grand Broulage, Haiti as well as providing solar powered computers, safety lighting, and playground equipment for the children.

From the Pastor's Desk

HAPPY NEW YEAR! As we begin this new liturgical year in the Church (Year B; Gospel of Mark for Sundays and Year II for weekdays for those keeping track at home), our beginning is kind of like our ending; a preparation for the second coming of our Lord. The Universal Norms for the Liturgical Year states "Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight." (39) So the warning in Mark's Gospel today comes from almost the ending in chapter 13, and reminds us to stay alert and be prepared just as the last weeks in Ordinary Time explain.

Take this time of preparation seriously, it always goes faster than we expect and we would be wise to plan our time accordingly. We have so many opportunities during this Advent Season to get ourselves in the right mindset. From availing ourselves to the Sacrament of Reconciliation to enjoying the sounds of the season with our Christmas Concert, Taize Prayer Service or Festival of Praise Adoration or just enjoying some silence while shopping or choosing to help out the less fortunate through our Giving Tree or Haiti Homebuilding Project. These are all opportunities to spend time with the Lord and grow closer to Him and to our brothers and sisters in Christ.

This week especially, we are blessed as a parish to celebrate our Feast Day on December 7th and 8th. I hope you come out on the Thursday evening to witness our Tree Lighting Ceremony. 
