



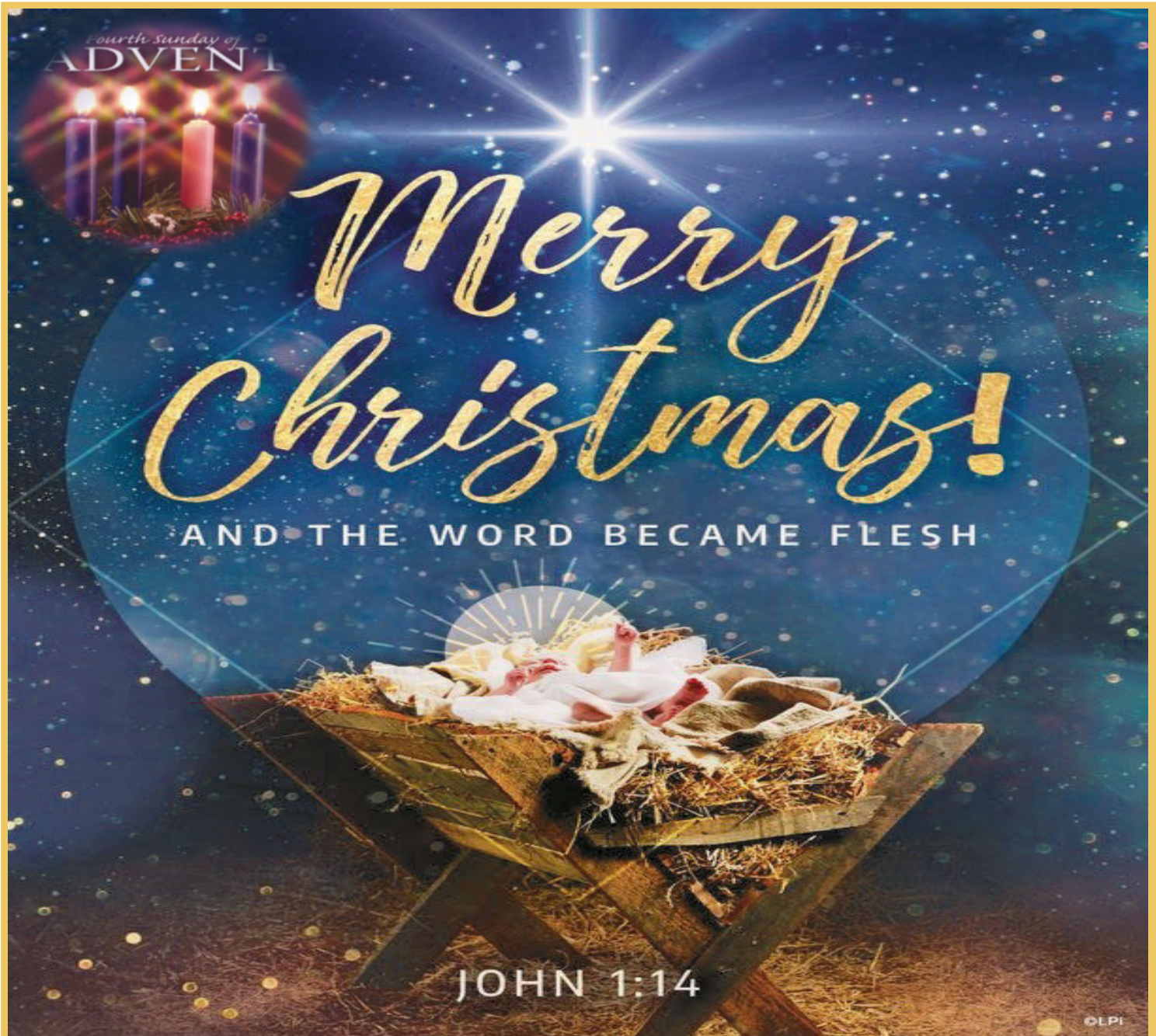

This year, thanks to an anonymous and generous donation, we received the book *Beautiful Eucharist*. Below is a moving excerpt from the book's introduction by Matthew Kelly. I found it powerful in helping people grasp why the faith is so important and I hope you do too! As we celebrate the Eucharistic Revival, it is my prayer this Christmas that as our Savior comes, we desire to be with Him more and more. ~Fr. Keith

*"There are a lot of things I love about being Catholic, but at the top of the list is the Eucharist. Most people have never really stopped to think about it, but the Eucharist is amazing.*

*I was asked once: What would have to happen for you to leave the Catholic Church? I thought about the question for a long time. I combed through the lowest moments in Catholic history, testing each to see if one of them would have been the breaking point that made me leave. But after thinking it through, I decided I could never leave the Catholic Church. The reason is because I believe that Jesus is truly present - body, blood, soul and divinity - in the Eucharist. Where else can I get the Eucharist?*

*At Mass on Sunday, the homily can be in a language I don't understand, the music could be a complete train wreck, there could be kids running up and down the aisles screaming at the top of their lungs, throwing crayons and eating snacks (or eating crayons and throwing snacks), and that's OK—because the moment when I receive the Eucharist is a pivotal moment of transformation, a moment when I get to receive who and what I wish to become. And I could never leave that. It doesn't matter how good the music or preaching is elsewhere; I cannot leave the Eucharist, I will not leave Jesus. I hope you won't either." - Matthew Kelly Beautiful Eucharist*



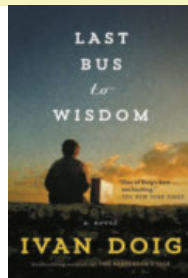
Keep "Christ" in Christmas!

## From the Pastor's Desk

Merry Christmas! It is hard to believe that it is already Christmas time again! I know that many of us have a whirlwind leadup to this holiday, including priests, and there never seems to be enough time. I hope that by celebrating and receiving our Lord in the Eucharist during this joyous time, God allows us a brief respite to experience the Peace of Christ in our hearts and minds.

One of the great traditions we have here at Immaculate Conception is that each year our Nativity is adorned with battery operated lights with the names of some of the individuals who are currently incarcerated at Edna Mahan and William Fauver prisons. I am blessed to work with some fine people within our parish to minister to their needs. Visiting the imprisoned is one of the corporal works of mercy, and I am often moved by the deep desire for our Lord in a place where hope and love can seem so far away. Many of the rules and restrictions limit the amount we are able to do and I have included below a copy of the Christmas cards that we send to the prison. Unfortunately, they are not allowed to have anything dangerous, so the cards that open up to a nativity scene are the closest thing they have to a manger in their cells. As we thank God for the many gifts He has given us this Christmas, especially the gift of Himself in the Eucharist, let us also pray for those that do not have the blessings that we have.

On behalf of Fr. Edgar, myself, and the Deacons we wish you and your family a very Merry Christmas! Know of our prayers for a healthy and safe New Year and thank you for choosing our Parish family!

### **ALTAR ROSARY SOCIETY**

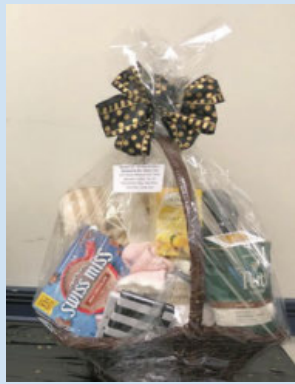

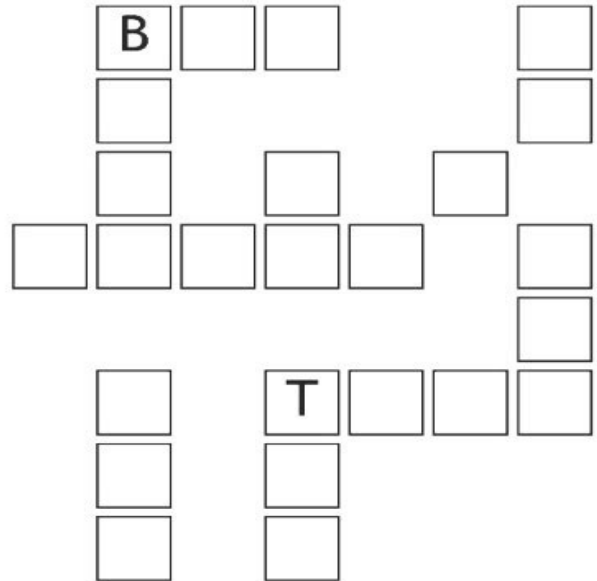
