From the Pastor's Desk

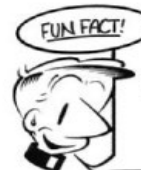

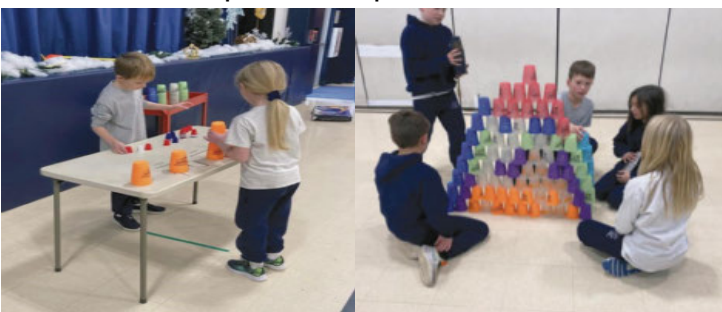


Before the break our ICS students got into the holiday spirit by telling the story of Jesus and spending time singing in Church.

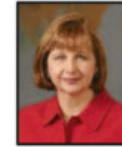

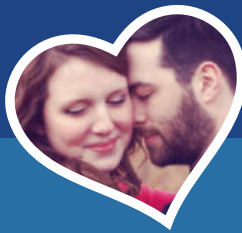
