I expected a complaint, yet he was just overjoyed with his ability to say yes to God & to receive Him daily. I'm often quick to complain when things aren't perfect or when I am a little uncomfortable. There are times that I am like Jonah in today's first reading reluctant at first, begrudging afterwards and saddened or even upset when things don't go my way even when I think I am following God. It is at times like these that God often puts individuals like that parishioner in my life. They remind me to focus on the many blessings we do have as well as the people he has put in our lives to help get us beyond the difficulties, instead of focusing on what we don't have. I was blessed last week to spend time with the Sisters of Jesus our Hope at their annual Epiphany celebration for priests at their mother house. I spent time with Fr. Jay and Msgr. Randy as well as Sr. Ellen, Sr. Christine, Sr. Lorraine and Sr. Anna whom I have been blessed to work with over the years as well as so many others. I thought about how thankful I am to be able to do this, not because it is easy or perfect, but often because of the imperfections and challenges we overcome... together.
