



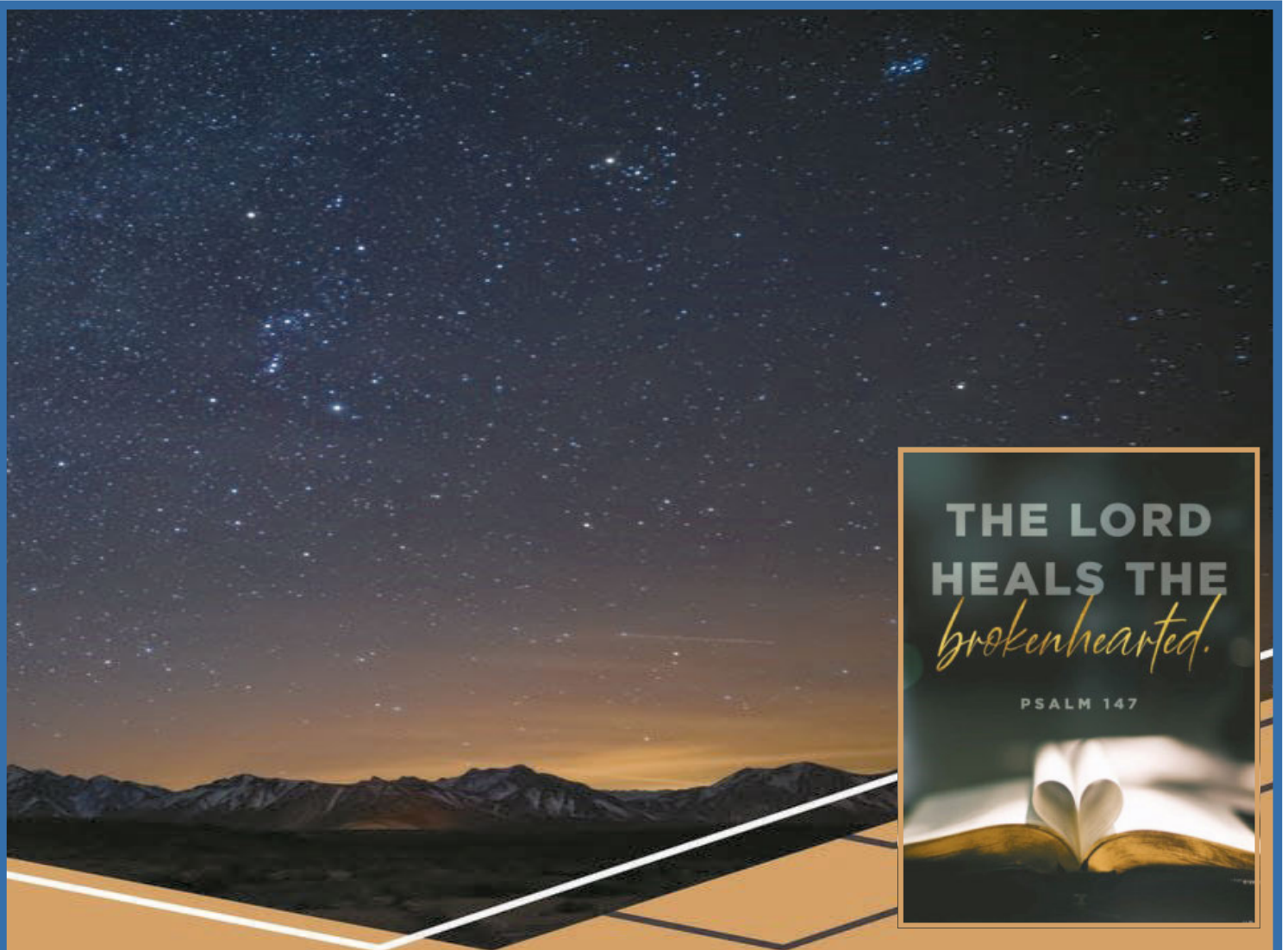

2024 LENTEN OBLIGATIONS



1. The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (February 14) and Good Friday (March 29).
2. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. (Feb. 16 & 23; Mar. 1, 8, 15 & 22)
3. Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal. The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.
4. Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.). The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

Please Note: This year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 (Valentine's Day). The obligation to fast does remain in effect, so it is suggested that those who are planning a special dinner make that their one main meal of the day.

From the Pastor's Desk



Job ends today's first reading: "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle; they come to an end without hope. Remember that my life is like the wind; I shall not see happiness again." and I couldn't help but think... Job must be a Buffalo Bills fan. All kidding aside, Job highlights a reality in this world, there is suffering. We can easily lose hope or become cynical when we hear the "Good News" since what many experience daily in this world can be so different than the "Joy" of the Gospel. It is actually one of the key arguments against the existence of God that even Aquinas recognizes in the Summa Theologica, namely, if God exists and He is all good why is there evil in the world? (Question 2, Article 3, Objection 1). While it is beyond the scope of this short article to delve deeply into this topic, I invite you to research a bit on your own. Read Aquinas or listen to Bishop Robert Barron's videos on the subject.

Mark in his first chapter that we read from today, talks about the sufferings of illness and possession. As Jesus begins to heal various people, Simon and others pursue Him and let Him know that *everyone* is looking for Him. This is really the case today, whether people realize it or not, everyone is looking for healing in their life, everyone is looking for Jesus because we suffer when we are not united with Him. Blaise Pascal once wrote in the 17th Century: "What else does this craving, and this helplessness, proclaim but that there was once in man a true happiness, of which all that now remains is the empty print and trace? This he tries in vain to fill with everything around him, seeking in things that are not there the help he cannot find in those that are, though none can help, since this infinite abyss can be filled only with an infinite and immutable object; in other words by God Himself." (*Pensées* Section VII [425]). As Catholics, we know where to seek the answer to our suffering; all hope is not lost. For those that haven't been given that gift yet, let us show them the way, the truth and the life that they seek.

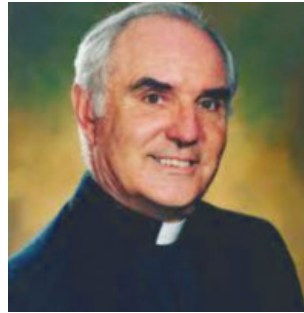

REST IN PEACE MSGR. CAPIK



Please remember in your prayers the repose of the soul of Reverend Monsignor William J. Capik, a retired priest of the Diocese of Metuchen, who passed away on January 27. Monsignor Capik was

ordained to the priesthood on June 4, 1955. He was pastor of St. James Parish in Basking Ridge for 24 years, before his retirement from active ministry in 2005.

CATECHETICAL QUESTIONS

Q: Is gossip a mortal sin?

A: To really ask this question, we must consider the 8th Commandment: "You shall not bear false witness."



In its reflections on this commandment, The Catechism of the Catholic Church invites us to not only think about what bearing "false witness" means, but to also consider how we understand the truth and how we communicate more broadly. This is why so much of this section of the Catechism has to do with the gift of language. With this in mind, we will notice that the word "gossip" isn't used by the Catechism. Instead, we find the words "detraction" and "calumny," which are actually two forms that gossip can take, and both can be quite serious.

First, detraction is the of revealing "another's faults and failings to persons who did not know them," without morally valid reasons. Calumny, by extension, is saying something about another person that is untrue, and it is sinful because it "harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgements" (see no. 2477).

In all of our communication, we have to always recognize that we have a moral obligation to the truth and to always work to protect the reputation and honor of our neighbors (see no. 2479).

Gossip can, in fact, prove to be a very serious sin. After all, the Catechism reminds us: "No one is bound to reveal the truth to someone who does not have the right to know it" (no. 2489). When we have gossiped, especially if we are aware we have damaged another person's good name or reputation, we want to make every effort to undo the damage we have done, including seeking the grace and forgiveness offered in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

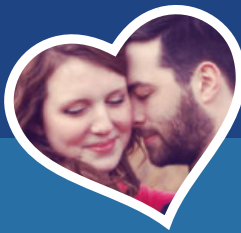

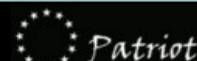
