

2024 LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

- 1. Good Friday (March 29) is a day of both fast and abstinence
- 2. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. (Feb. 23; Mar. 1, 8, 15 & 22)
- 3. Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal. The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.
- 4. Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.). The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.



From the Pastor's Desk


"This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." (Mark 1:15) These three sentences are the essence of everything Jesus taught; it is the central idea of Christ's mission to the world. Most importantly this text requires a response of repentance and faith... but it must be out of love, not out of obligation. As we begin the Lenten Season, I have a plethora of times of Penance, for the school, for PREP, our own Penance Service and a myriad of other churches and schools. Especially when it comes to elementary school and PREP, we march the entire class over to the Church. The line of young people can be similar in appearance to the line at a store (OK, next customer). However, the main point of this is getting them comfortable with something that we hope will be an important part of their life. I would tell my students in high school that we don't really do that once they're at that grade level; sure we have times of Reconciliation—but they should know when and if they need to go to Confession and it is always available. That's what adults do as well.

Repent, and believe in the Gospel... those go hand-in-hand. When we sin, we don't follow the Gospel message. If we don't want to repent, can we really say that we believe in the Gospel? Jesus states this in the first chapter of Mark's Gospel! Lent gives us an opportunity to go into the desert with the Lord. We know we aren't perfect and need to get right with God. This is the time of fulfillment, when we get away from the distractions of our life to focus on what is truly important and to confirm our faith in Him. My brothers and sisters in Christ, make this Lent a true time of fulfillment of prayer, fasting & almsgiving and you will see the Kingdom of God is truly at hand.




