



ALL ABOUT LENT 2025 LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

Bishop Checchio has approved this year's Lenten Obligations

- 1. The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).
- 2. The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28; April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.
- 3. Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal. The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.
- 4. Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.). The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

From the Pastor's Desk

I wish Jeremiah's words in today's first reading were not true. "Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings, who seeks his strength in flesh.... Blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose hope is the LORD." I remember having a discussion with a friend who was not very religious explaining that I had been given the gift of faith. He responded to me that he had faith as well - faith in his friends, faith in me. I tried my best to not insult him, but simply stated that while I would do my best to keep his faith in me. inevitably I was human and I would let him down. Unfortunately, a few years later it proved to be true, not out of malicious intent, but just in being human. I wasn't there when he needed me the most and while it didn't completely destroy our friendship, and I still love him like a brother, our relationship is nowhere near what it was. I asked for forgiveness and got it, but I believe the faith he felt during that conversation will never return. Even worse, I feel now, as a priest, that I had an opportunity to bring him closer to God and failed and that I still fail at times because of my human nature. I often remind people that all of us our sinners, even His priests, and, consequently to never to let our disappointment in priests, religious or daily Communicants affect our relationship with God. Never let a human being stop you from knowing God. We've all been hurt and disappointed, even by people we know and love and proport to love God, but Paul reminds us: "Not only that, but we even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character,

and proven character. hope, and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the h Holy Spirit that has been given to us."







2025-2026 CATHOLIC SCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS OPEN

Families interested in applying for tuition assistance to attend an eligible Diocese of Metuchen elementary (like ICS) or high school may apply online now through FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. Online applications must be completed (including all required documentation) by no later than March 31, 2025. A signed Parish Verification Form is also required by the Diocese, and should be signed by your Pastor, and submitted to the school or schools your children attend.

Applications are available in English and Spanish. Families that need assistance completing the online application or need access to a computer to apply should contact their school.

IN THE END, DOES IT MATTER?

When I was a teenager, the priest I would go to for confession used to tell me, over and over: "In the end, we all get the same dirty hole in the ground."

What he meant was, it doesn't matter how rich or smart or well-liked we are. We're all heading to the same place. This life comes to an end for every man. All the money he earns, all the stuff, all the worldly esteem, will at some point be of no further use. We all get the same dirty hole in the ground.

It was an important message for me to hear, because at the time, it all seemed so important: my after-school job and my FAFSA application and my grades. The admiration of my friends and teachers. I was so consumed with what I was going to become that I wasn't spending a lot of time thinking about who I was going to become. But the who is the only thing that lasts until the next life.

And to be honest, it's all still too important to me. Avoiding sadness and disappointment. Saving money and being liked. Focusing on "the five-year plan" when it comes to career, house plans, and a whole bunch of other things I can't take to my dirty hole in the ground.

Jesus was radical in His teaching that the "stuff" in life wasn't all that important. It was radical for Him to say that the worldly signs of success wealth, popularity, pleasure — did not amount to a whole lot in the grand scheme of things and that suffering could sanctify us. It was radical in the ancient world, and it's radical today.

Are we ready to be radical, too?
