BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

It is a great honor to be selected as a Godparent or Sponsor, but it is not just a title for the Catholic Church. According to Canon Law: "a person to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A Sponsor

also helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it."

Certificates of Eligibility for sponsorship for Baptism or Confirmation will be given **only to active** (weekly Mass attendance) **registered** parishioners of ICC. Qualified members should use the QR code.



On the Journey to Priesthood

On March 2, 2025, His Eminence, Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle, Pro-prefect of the Dicastery for Evangelization, conferred the Ministry of Acolyte in the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception at the Pontifical North American College, Vatican City State, on 26 seminarians, including our Diocese of Metuchen seminarian, Bruce Cargill. In the rite of the Institution of Acolyte, Cardinal Tagle placed the paten, which contains the hosts for the celebration of Mass, in the hands of each candidate. He then said, "Take this vessel with bread for the celebration of the Eucharist. Make your life worthy of your service at the table of the Lord and of his Church." pastoral visit. He will be celebrating the 4:30 PM Vigil Mass, all are welcome to attend this celebration with our Bishop!


From the Pastor's Desk

Perhaps you already knew that the picture in the back of the Church (on the lefthand side if your are coming in or the righthand side if you are coming out) is Rembrandt's The Return of the Prodigal Son. Msgr. Randy said he had it placed there near the confessional to remind us of the loving presence of our Heavenly Father and his desire to return to Him, no matter what we have done. What you may not have known is this is among Rembrandt's final works, completed within 2 years of his death in 1669. During this time when we walk with Jesus towards His own death at Calvary, we naturally contemplate our mortality. Yet, we also celebrate the things that we have accomplished and rejoice for the many things we have gotten to witness through our life.

We celebrate Laetare Sunday today, the fourth week in Lent, and we rejoice in the love that God gives us. In too many of our human relationships there are limits to the love we are willing to pour out. Our hearts have been broken and we tend to hold grudges for past hurts. Thank God, our Lord does not. I know that I often picture myself in the story as the faithful son, the one who is upset with his returning brother and probably thinks his father is naïve to someone who he thinks will just break his heart again. After all, the younger Son, in wanting his inheritance now, is basically saying "you are dead to me" to his father. However, are we not doing exactly that when we choose to sin? Our Lord reminds us that His forgiveness is for all of His sons and daughters; many of us don't realize the difficulties of life when we are apart from God, but many do.


So, as we enter into this most sacred time of our year, let us continue to work on how we can mimic the Father's love and joy for His sons. Let us pray that as we experience His mercy and compassion for us when we sin; we, too, may be instruments of that mercy in those that may have sinned against us. This is, after all, what our Father desires.






