

BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

It is a great honor to be selected as a Godparent or Sponsor, but it is not just a title for the Catholic Church.

According to Canon Law: "a person to be baptized is to be given a

sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A Sponsor also helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it." Certificates of Eligibility for sponsorship for Baptism or Confirmation will be given only to active (weekly Mass attendance) registered parishioners of ICC. Qualified members should use the QR code.

PREPARING FOR EASTER

We invite all of you to join us in taking some downtime to prepare for the Triduum. During Holy Week all regular meetings at IC are canceled. The only events that are going on are those that are either part of the services and para-liturgical events or practice/setup for those events. We invite you as well to maintain a reverent silence during this week in your life to truly enter into this holiest time of year.

JOIN US FOR MORNING PRAYER DURING THE TRIDUUM.

There are no daily Masses on Thursday, Friday or Saturday and the time for the Saturday Vigil is moved until after the sun goes down-this is a universal Church practice. In lieu of Daily Mass, the clergy will be leading the Liturgy of the Hours. This is the prayer of the Church that priests and deacons promise to pray daily. Throughout the four-week Psalter, all 150 Psalms will be prayed and the day is broken up so that you know that someone in the world is always praying. Join us for these beautiful times of prayer.

CHRISM MASS - TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 4PM Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi, Metuchen

Bishop James F. Checchio will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of the Diocese. At the Mass, all priests make a Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service, the Bishop will bless & consecrate the Holy Oils, which each parish receives for the rites of anointing. The Oil of Catechumens is used to anoint infants and adults before



their Baptism; the Oil of the Sick is used of the infirm in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; and Sacred Chrism is used to anoint the newly baptized, confirmandi, and the hands of a priest at his ordination, as well as the head of a bishop, and the altar and walls of new churches. 

From the Pastor's Desk

We have now entered into Holy Week, after being tested in the desert for 40 days, how have we done? These five+ weeks always seem to go so quickly. In this Year C cycle we walk with Luke's Gospel on this Palm Sunday. What stood out when looking at the Passion from Luke this year was the unique line found in Luke: "Simon, Simon, behold Satan has demanded to sift all of you like wheat, but I have prayed that your own faith may not fail; and once you have turned back, you must strengthen your brothers." Peter is addressed by Jesus with his old name to begin with, a sign that the rock will crumble in this time of struggle (in the next line Jesus says the familiar "I tell you Peter, before the cock crows this day, you will deny three times that you know me"), Peter does go back to his roots after Jesus' death - he even tells his brothers later "I am going fishing" - his old job. However, in that initial quote, Jesus also is telling him not to give up, that he needs to be the source of strength for the other Apostles once he turns back. This is a reminder to all of us, especially if we failed during our Lenten practices, to never give up on the faith, hope and especially love of Christ. Jesus experiences the triumphant entry into Jerusalem and the almost immediate fall into crucifixion and once again joyful resurrection. Our lives are filled with these ups and downs, and our faith life is often no different. There are times that we play each part in the Passion Narrative, we are all at one time: Our Blessed Mother, the Apostles, Pilate, the Pharisees, Simon of Cyrene, the women of Jerusalem, Jospeh of Arimathea, the centurion, the thief and countless others. We have our moments of great faith and fail miserably and deny we even know Jesus. We are at both times sinners and saints. That is the beauty of the Passion, depending on when we are here, we identify with all of them. Yet, we too are called as Simon Peter did, to turn back, and to strengthen our brothers and sisters. May this truly be a Holy Week for each of us and may we be victorious with Christ who does this to defeat the effects of Pax et bonum, sin.


