HAITI UPDATE

As a result of your generosity in last years Haiti Home Building Project, we were able to finance the construction of 13 homes for desperate families struggling to survive. Eight of those homes have been completed and the pictures of the families have been placed on the "Haiti Wall" in the lower level of the church. Hopefully, the remaining five homes will be completed this year.

As you know, gang violence in the Port-au-Prince area has been bad, resulting in a delay in getting building supplies into the area. However, I have been advised that the violence has eased and construction of homes has begun again. Please pray for the people of Haiti and for an end to the violence. ~Deacon Bill



From the Pastor's Desk

On the cover of the bulletin is a picture I took when I visited Crater Lake National Park the day after my retreat in Oregon. It is one of the most beautiful places I have visited in the world. What I found most interesting as I was hiking around and pausing at the beautiful blue lake and the reflections of the mountains, was that this was all caused by a collapse of a volcano almost 8,000 years ago. What was a catastrophic event that left the area looking like a wasteland eventually filled with water from rain and snow (there are no rivers or streams that feed the lake) and left this awe-inspiring place. It is one of the most pristine lakes in the world and the deepest lake of the United States. I thought about the life of Christ and our own lives, even though often there are great tragedies and pain and suffering that occur, we shouldn't lose hope. Just as Crater Lake became something that would have been unthinkable after the devastation that destroyed the landscape, our Risen Lord gives us the hope that we can rise with Him into something beautiful and unique. Often nature gives us a time to pause and reflect on the cycle of life - death and resurrection. So, do not let your hearts be troubled. God is not done with us.

I also thought about what Fr. Nicodemus had said last week about the need for water in the

Diocese of Kitui. Unfortunately, this is a problem in many parts of the world and will likely be the main resource issue of our future. Crater Lake has



approximately 4.9 trillion gallons of fresh water, enough to give each one of the 8 billion people in the world a gallon of water every day for over a year. However, the average American uses 82 gallons of water a day (according to the US Geological Survey), so this isn't even a drop in the bucket (pun intended). The entire lake would be drained by the US in less than half a year. Just something to ponder when we want to take a long shower: Remember although we see the island, there is a mountain below the water of which we are only witnessing the very top.


