






#### TENEBRAE TALKS



# From the Pastor's Desk

Abraham left his homeland and everything he knew at 75 years old and waited another 10 years for a male heir that God had promised him. Moses led his people through the wilderness away from Egypt to the Promised Land for 40 years and never got to step foot in it himself. Jacob had a battle with his brother for an inheritance and had to flee his home: he also spent 14 years of service (7 more than he anticipated) before he could marry the woman he desired in Rachel. Do you think that at any moment in these men's lives they didn't ponder quitting or at the very least questioning the plan God had for them? We know for a fact from Scripture, that Abraham takes it upon himself to remedy the situation, Jacob had to flee because of he and his mother's actions against his father and brother and Moses contends with many questions throughout his journey. "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." We hear this in our second reading from the Letter to the Hebrews.

Years of following God without fully realizing what we had initially thought we were seeking, how many of us question and doubt His plan for us? How many give up hope after much shorter times of trial? One of my fond memories as a teenager was waking up early to stand in line for tickets for various concerts of bands I wanted to see or sporting events, sometimes even camping out the night before to try my best to make sure I was at that event... it didn't always work... but the experience itself was one I recall much more than the nights of those shows. Sometimes it is only through the journey or struggle that we fully appreciate that our true desires are fulfilled. Our Lord in the Gospel tells us to remain vigilant and keep the faith despite things perhaps not working out as we planned. Often people say "Patience is a virtue" to which I reply "yeah, one that I don't have." It's ok to get frustrated, to question, to not comprehend fully; but just stay on the path, don't give up and you will still be walking with God.


