




# TENEBRAE TALKS


# From the Pastor's Desk

I have good news and I have bad news. How does that phrase make you feel? Which do you want to hear first? Do you even want to hear the bad news at all? For those of you who are uncomfortable already by just reading those words in my weekly article, rest assured, I am not setting you up for something bad that is happening in the parish or my life.

The words of Jesus in the Gospel today often make people uncomfortable: the Prince of Peace telling us he did not come to bring peace but division. That can't be right, can it? I thought Jesus came to unify us, not divide, especially in our families. Jesus came to testify to the truth -He wants to understand The Good News, but He doesn't disregard the bad news. We need a savior, we are sinners, but God has provided that for us. Jeremiah came to speak the truth as well to his people, but they didn't want to hear the truth because it meant changing their lives. So, they threw him in a cistern to silence him. In our desire to be comfortable and not change, do we try to silence other voices? Voices that might be trying to help us to be more Christ-like? Do we only focus on the fact that "Jesus loves you" and disregard the "go and sin no more" aspect of His teaching or vice versa? Our Lord is both a loving savior and a just judge. None of us are worthy on our own; yet our Lord desires to make us worthy.

Our second reading today asks us to "consider how He (Jesus) endured such opposition from sinners in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart." Opposing views occur all the time when trying to not only live out, but pass on the faith. We don't shy away from opposition, we are called to take up our cross and engage it. Sometimes that is even in our own families or families of faith, the question we are ultimately left with is: who do we serve more: our God or ourselves? A theme song from the 80's helps me keep things in perspective. "You take the good, you take the bad, you take them both and there you have the Facts of Life."




