




BOOK TALK

A Brief Reminder About Political Activity on St. Mary's Hill

We want to remind everyone that there should be no political activity of specific candidates on ICC grounds (handing out flyers, posting materials, etc). From the Pastor's Desk

"God, come to my assistance. O Lord, make haste to help me." Every day, I say this phrase multiple times as I pray the Liturgy of the Hours, yet since this is often on my own, I have to admit that I don't give it a whole lot of thought. This week as Fr. Jose and I attended the convocation with the priests of the Diocese of Metuchen, we had the opportunity to pray together aloud and those words stood out. In every hour of the day, we need to rely on God alone.

Through our reading from Exodus, we have a very physical example of this spiritual truth. Moses and the Israelites are being attacked and. as long as he holds his hands up in prayer, Israel is winning the battle. However, he gets tired, he drops his hands and Israel begins to lose. He needs the assistance of Aaron and Hur to support him so that his people can be victorious and their people survive. We too get fatigued: physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually and we cannot do it on our own. At times, we need to be propped up by others so that we can fight off the attacks from those who wish us harm. Most importantly, we need to ask God to consistently come to our assistance. I believe that is the point of our convocation - lifting each other up in prayer and fraternity.

I walked in on a conversation in the sacristy between Deacon Mark and Deacon Joe, about the necessity of retreats I took the opportunity to suggest that they plan to go on retreat together or with all their brother deacons (note, they were already talking about it, so I really didn't help, but it's the thought that counts). We call the family the domestic church - it is the primary responsibility of spouses to lift each other up in our relationship with God as well as be the first and best teachers of their children. There are so many things that can tire us out that we can lose that focus. It is one of the things I love about Walking with Purpose, that babysitting is included - let us worry about the kids for now - go spend some time with God. As I said in my homily last week, it is why the Lord gives us the Sabbath - we need that refreshment, we need Him in the Eucharist. Today's Responsorial Psalm is another phrase that we often have a memorized response to from Pontifical Blessings: Our help is in the name of the Lord, who made Heaven & Earth. May it always guide us.
