





Jonathan was a local resident having moved from Philadelphia with his parents to High Bridge before his second birthday. He lived in High Bridge until his family moved to Lebanon Township in 1995. Jonathan attended High Bridge Elementary and Middle School and Voorhees High School. Tragically Jonathan was killed in March 2003 in a single car accident while at St. Mary's College of Maryland just 2 months before he was to graduate. Jonathan was a truly unique and gifted individual naturally athletic, outgoing, intelligent, respectful, creative, articulate and expressive. He wanted people to be happy and could brighten one's day with his infectious smile, sense of humor or unique stories. Jonathan loved life, had a playful heart and could interact comfortably with anyone. His ability to connect with people allowed Jonathan to have a tremendous impact on those around him despite his young age. For these qualities he was respected and well-liked by all. We dedicate this blood drive in Jonathan's memory and hope that your support will continue to give life to others and keep his legacy alive.

From the Pastor's Desk

The story of the repentant thief has always been one of my favorite minor characters in the Gospel. I always recall the words of one of my professors: "the last thing that the he stole was Heaven." I like the story because it reminds me of two very important things: a) the abundant mercy and desire of our God to always call us back to Him and b) the choice of free will in that two people in the exact same situation can react in two completely different ways. On this feast of Christ the King of the Universe, the question we have to ask ourselves is "who do we serve?" Do we "go rejoicing to the House of the Lord?" Do we grumble about having to go to Church or when someone asks us to donate our time, talent or treasure in His name? Do we just ignore God completely? Or are we overtly hostile to God and mock him and the people of faith? Even those who profess the faith can act in very un-Christian ways at times, we all choose to serve ourselves at times when we sin. You have heard me say plenty of times, sin can simply be thought of as saying "God, I know what you are asking me, but I am choosing to do this... I am choosing myself."

I also love this story because people know it well - unfortunately, often they will use it to justify their sinful actions, but it gives me an opportunity to say that they are right - God will always forgive us, nothing we can do can take away His love, all we need to do is ask and be sincere about that desire. When I agree they then ask, "so then why not just live how I want to now and ask for forgiveness at the end of my life?" The question I ask them back is: after consistently denying a relationship with God, will we be sincere in our desire for Him or are we still just trying to serve ourselves? Will we even ask for forgiveness?

In the older form of the act of contrition, we say: "I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell, *but most of all* because they offend thee, my God, who are all good and worthy of *all my love*..." Sure, we want to get to Heaven and avoid Hell, but our heart needs to ultimately be poured out like His - completely and filled with truth... We can't fool God, he knows our desires. We need to guard against the sin of presumption along with the sins of commission and omission. The coming season of Advent gives us a perfect time to truly become ready for His coming by seeking Him here & now.




