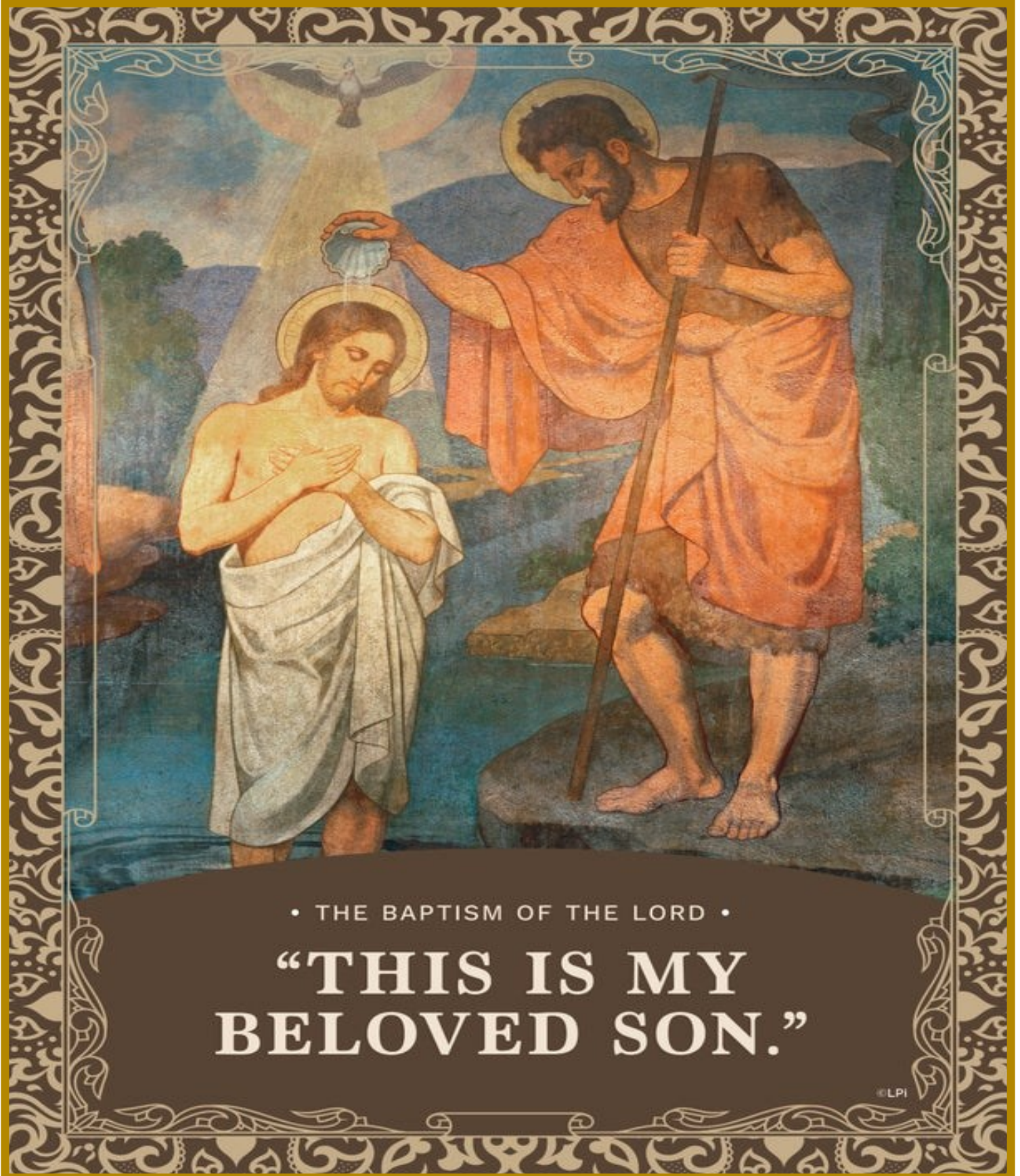

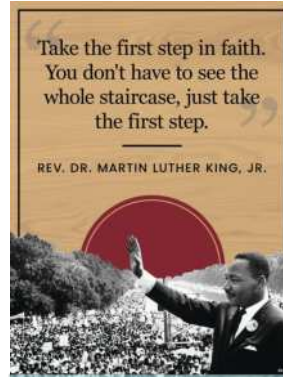

On Monday, January 19<sup>th</sup> for the celebration of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. Let us pray for peace and justice and an end of all attacks on human life, and may we work to make our dreams a reality.

## **WILL YOU BE BLESSED THIS YEAR?**

The Feast of the Epiphany, which we celebrated last week, is a huge feast in the Orthodox Church. For the 120<sup>th</sup> time in Tarpon Springs, Florida the feast was commemorated by the community on January 6<sup>th</sup> (the traditional date of the Epiphany). Known for its sponge diving industry, the water is an important part of their history and life. After the Divine Liturgy is celebrated at St. Nicholas Cathedral, the clergy and faithful process to Spring Bayou where the Archbishop blesses the waters. The Gospel is read and a white dove signifying the Holy Spirit is released. As the dove is released, the Archbishop throws a cross into the bayou and all of the young men in the community dive to retrieve it. The one doing so is considered blessed for the year.

This beautiful tradition, while not *Roman Catholic*, shows the importance of living one's baptismal promises out proudly, incorporating the faith into our everyday lives and standing as a public witness to what we believe. Just like the simple act of blessing our homes with chalk to welcome those into our homes with a sign of faith reminds us that we too are God's beloved daughters and sons daily. You might not need to dive for a cross in the waters of Florida to be blessed, just the fact that you were Baptized states that you are and changes your forever. We know that, but do *our* traditions tell others that as well?

O Lord, Shepherd of Shepherds, we turn to you seeking your grace, that we in the Diocese of Metuchen may be given a bishop who is a shepherd after your heart and will guide us, your flock, to be a faithful flock and fruitful field in union with you now and for eternity. Amen.

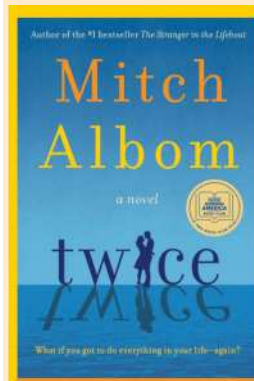

### **ST. HILARY OF POITIERS, BISHOP AND DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH | JANUARY 13**

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353.

Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.

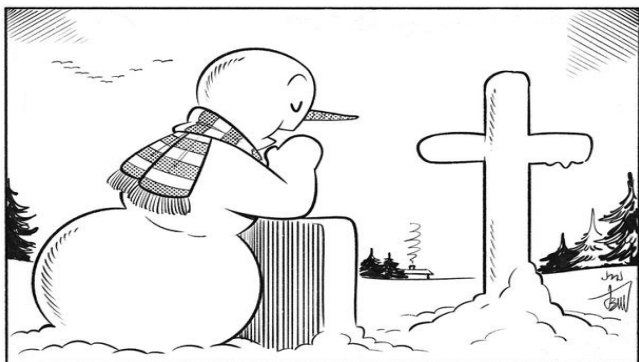

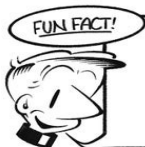

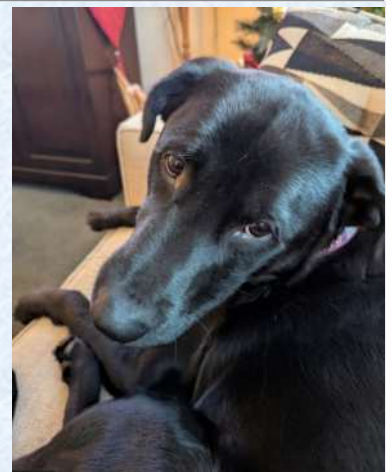

### TENEBRAE TALKS

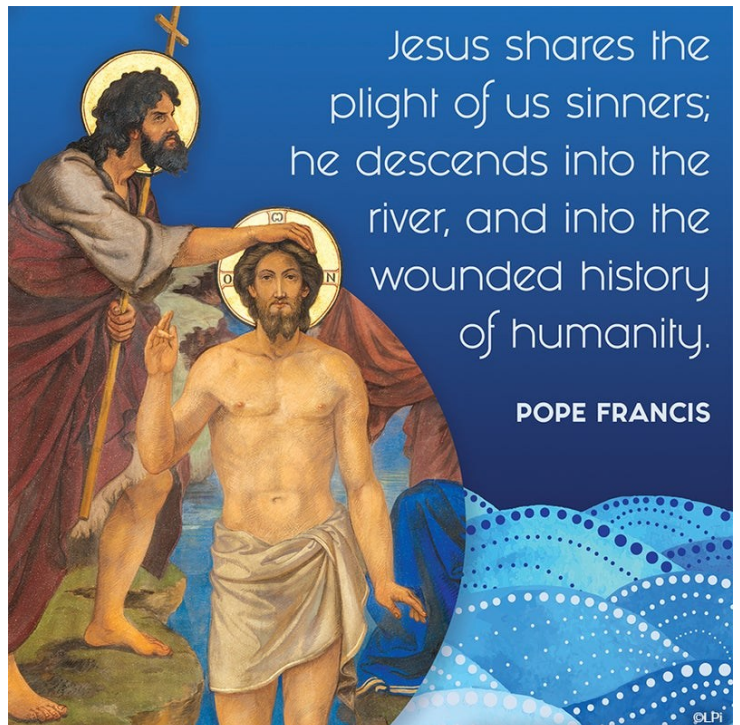

I was blessed to enjoy my time away in Florida with my best friend, but since I've been there a number of times it can be rare to find something new to do, but I was pleased to find a few new trips. Firstly, we headed off to arguably the greatest bowl game of the season, The Pop-Tarts Bowl, and yes "The People's Championship" did not disappoint. For those who don't know, the trophy is an actual functional toaster and there are tons of anthropomorphic Pop-Tarts dancing & competing (**Team Sprinkles** vs. Team Swirls) in an attempt to be awarded the honor of being offered up to be toasted at the end of the game. 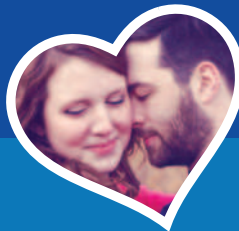
