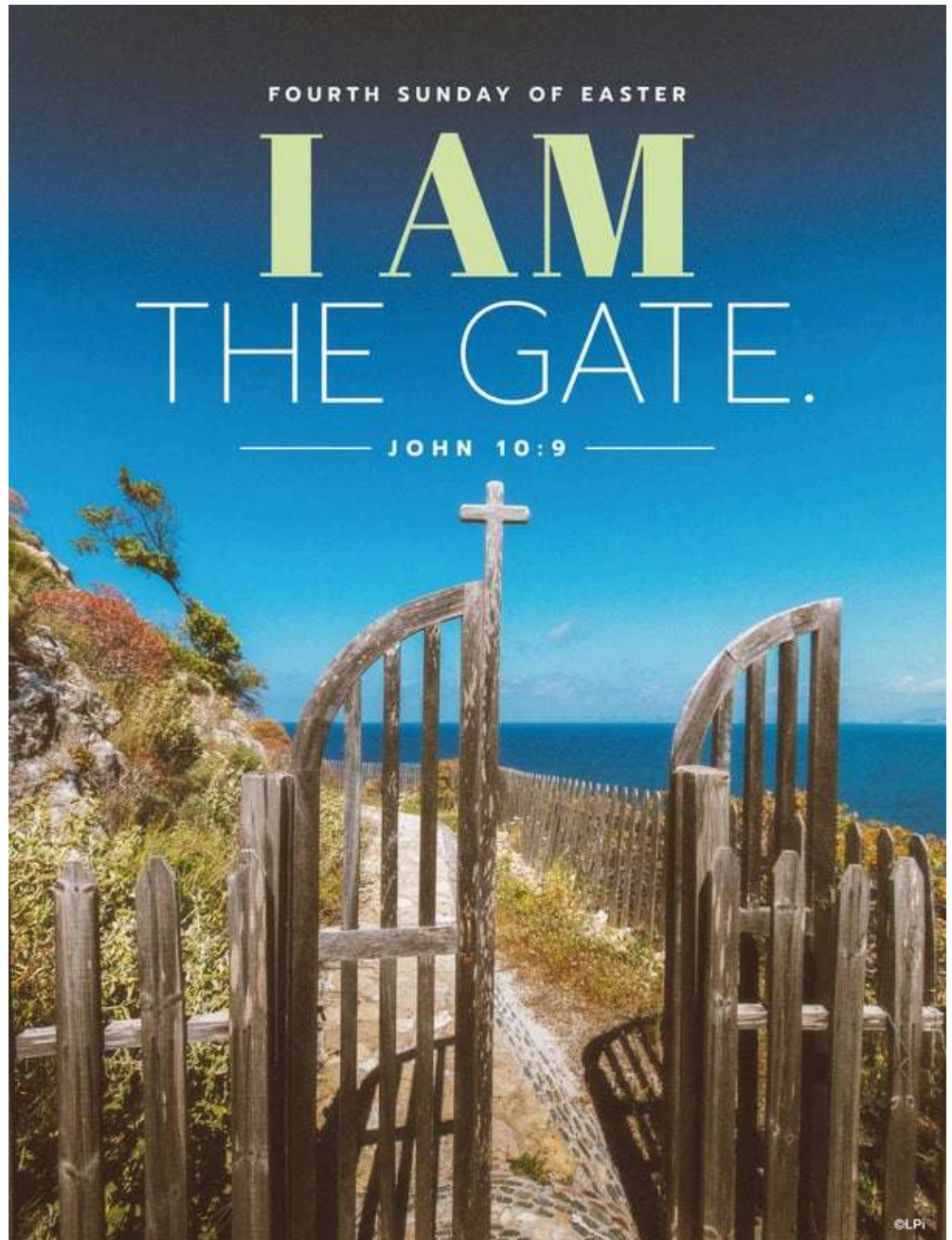

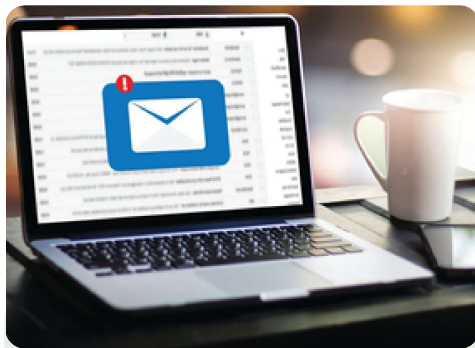

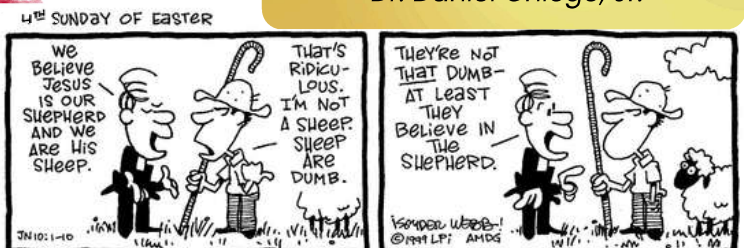
## NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want

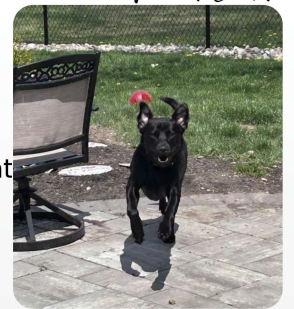
Probably the best known of the Psalms, Psalm 23 is often used to bring comfort to those in mourning and those struggling through dark times to give hope. Today, the Church celebrates Good Shepherd Sunday in which that Psalm is joined with the tenth chapter of the Gospel of John. While Jesus clearly is the Good Shepherd (which is stated in verse 11 and 14), our reading today stops at verse 10. We are left with the beginning of this discourse, in which Jesus refers to himself as the gate for the sheep. "I am the gate, whoever enters through me will be saved and will come in and go out and find pasture." The gate gives the sheep a safe place with the shepherd, but at the same time they must be out in the world as well. There is danger, there are thieves and robbers that want to take the sheep from the shepherd, but they will not pass through the gate.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, we also celebrate the world day of prayer for Vocations. To listen to whom the Lord might be calling to lead His people by their life to that gate of Baptism and life with the Lord. It does not mean we are perfect, far from it. I think of that line from Psalm 23 which I use to comfort others as well as myself, I do believe it and try to live it out, but there are also times when I do want things that while good are not really important. For instance right now, I want the Mets to win a game already, it is something I want badly, but I also know in the grand scheme of things, where and to whom I belong. This is our vocation, our calling, to see that we have the safety in the Good Shepherd, even when things are dark and we are called to return to what is truly important.

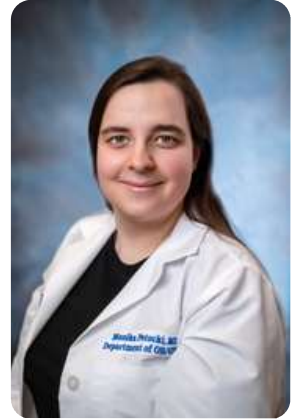

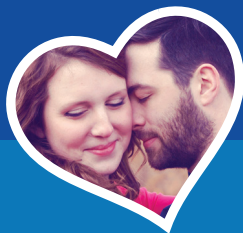

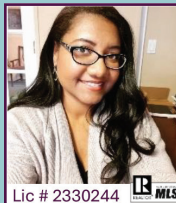
