## 7th Grade Accelerated Math Policies 2023-2024

- To stay in accelerated math a student should maintain an 85 and $S$ in effort. If a student falls below an 85 for any trimester, a reassessment of their placement may be considered.
- In order for a student to be considered for Algebra the following year, a student must attain a 90 average for the year and at least an $S$ in effort each trimester.
- Homework typically should take students approximately 15-20 minutes to complete each night. If it is taking students longer such as 45 minutes - 1 hour or doesn't know how to do it at all, that might be a sign your child is struggling with the advanced curriculum.
- If homework is missed consistently, a reassessment of your child's math placement may be considered.

This is an accelerated class and as such the curriculum will be more challenging and move at a faster pace. This class maintains a fast pace that may take students time to adjust to. Your child may not receive the grades that you or he/she is accustomed to. If your child begins to feel overwhelmed or anxious by the content or pace please reach out to me and we can have a conversation about support and continued placement.

Please know that all grades will be posted in a timely manner. The Powerschool portal is the best place for you as a parent to stay up-to-date on your child's progress. Please see my syllabus for extra-help support times and days.
