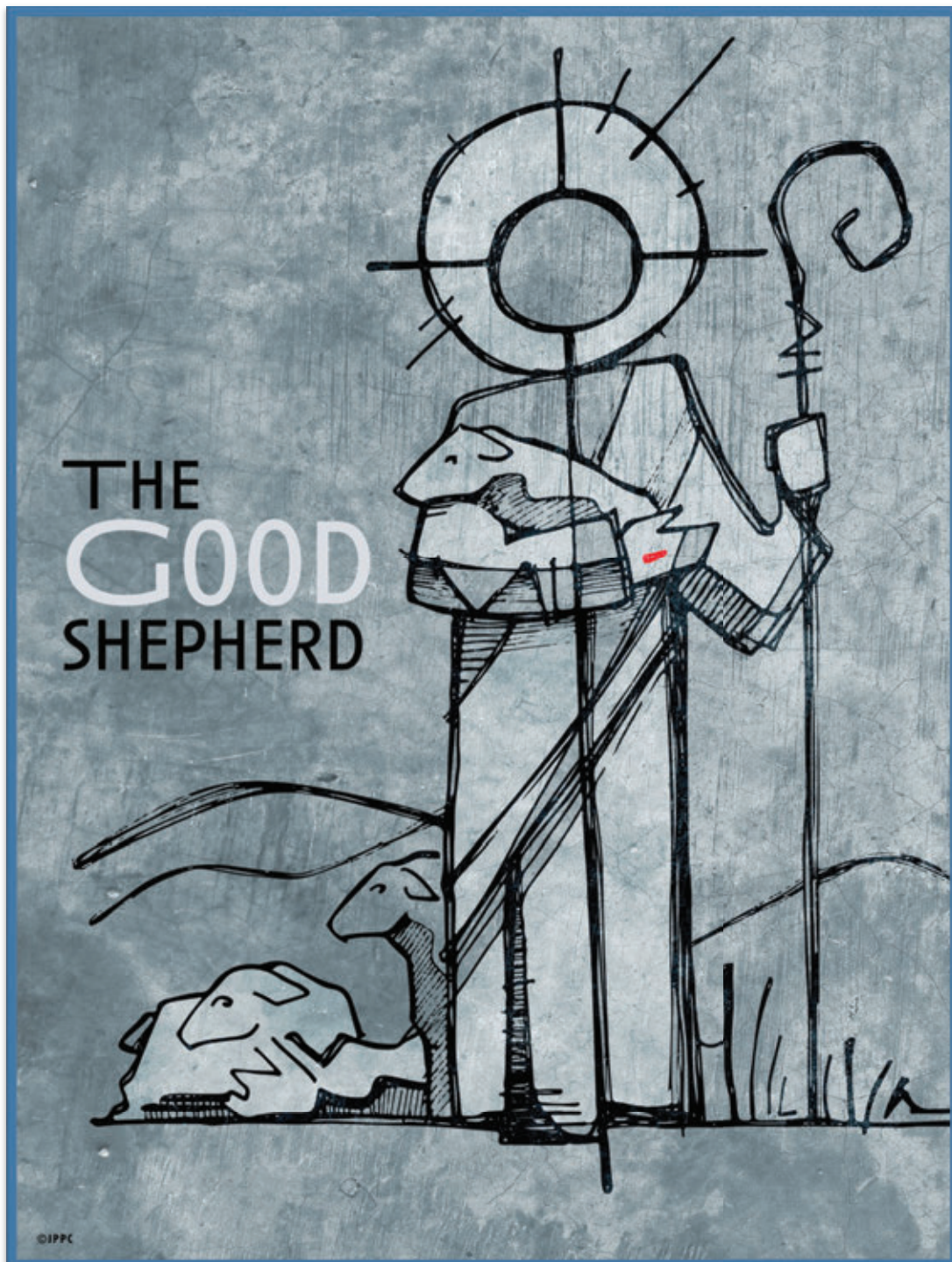

LETTER FROM FATHER MIKE

Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to all who celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation on Friday! Thank you to their families and catechists who have supported them on their formation journey. The latter part of their preparation has been very different, as all learning has been done virtually during the pandemic. The preparation phase has now ended and all are ready to accept their mission as disciples of Jesus in our world. We encourage them to be together in a spirit of belonging on that journey.

Next weekend, we begin sharing the Eucharist with younger members in all three of our parishes. It is another step for them and their families. The hunger for the Eucharist in all our lives has been building, as throughout the past year so many of us have not been able to share in it. Now, more and more, we are coming together cherishing this most sacred of gifts and supporting one another as we take the Body of Christ into our lives. These younger members and their families depend on all of us to offer them example as they share with us this wonderful beginning in their spiritual journey.

One of the experiences of church that I am always aware of is a sense that we do not realize that the Sacraments of Initiation or vocation are celebrations for everyone; they are not private to the families involved. Just the opposite, they are signs of God's presence in our lives, and every one of us is engaged whether physically present or not. We can be spiritually present and pray with those who are celebrating. May each of us consider that role during these weeks when so many are celebrating Sacraments as part of their journey of initiation.

Monday we honor the Feast of St. George. We will have Mass at 7:30 in the evening at St. George Church. Saturday is the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker and it also begins the month of May, during which we invite one another to special devotion to Mary, Our Blessed Mother. All three of our parishes have statues honoring Mary on the grounds. Please make a visit to one of them and pray a decade of the Rosary either sitting in your car or walking around, if weather permits. We have a member who sits in his car and prays the Rosary every evening at one of the shrines. When I see him there, I always appreciate his devotion.

In This Week's Gospel...

This Fourth Sunday of Easter we reflect on who God is to us. You may have noticed that this Gospel contains one of the seven "I Am" statements in the Gospel of John. Jesus tells the disciples that He is the Good Shepherd who gives up His life for His sheep. This stands in comparison to the hired workers who run away at the first sign of a wolf. The distinction being made here is important to our Christian faith because personal relationship is of the utmost priority. Jesus loves each of us unconditionally as unique individuals, not because He has to but because of His abundant love for Creation. Do we do our best to love our neighbors as Jesus loves us? Do we add conditions to our love?

This week, spend some time reflecting on who Jesus is for you. Ask yourself how you can love your neighbors unconditionally, as He loves you. 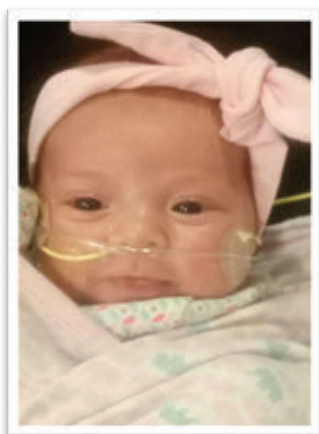

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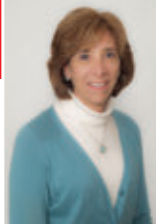
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
