








## MEDITATION FOR April 30, 2023

The sheep follow Christ because they recognize his voice.

Jesus Christ, our Good Shepherd, is calling us today. He is present, leading us. Christ does not speak

only in miraculous visions or through Scripture and through His disciples. Just as Christ sent Peter to preach, He sends His Faithful out to call His sheep today.

In the first reading, Peter proclaims Christ crucified and the people are *cut to the heart*, asking what to do. Peter calls them to repent and be baptized, and *about three thousand persons were added that day*. In the second reading, Peter writes of the suffering Christ endured that *we might live for righteousness*. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches that He is the shepherd and the gate who protects and guides His sheep.

How often do we take time to discern what Jesus wants from us? Are our prayers always petitions, asking Jesus to do things for us? If so, that's a one-sided relationship. 


