We are excited to inform you that registration is now open for the upcoming Drivers Education program at St. John the Baptist High School. This program is designed to provide students with the essential skills and knowledge to become safe, responsible, and confident drivers.

## Program Details:

- **Dates:** February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026 thru June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026
- **Location:** St. John the Baptist DHS
- **Schedule:** Driving Sessions held Monday – Friday afternoons 3:00 – 4:30 and 4:30 – 6:00
- **Schedule:** Possible Lecture Sessions: Wednesday or Friday Morning 6:15AM – 7:45AM, Friday Afternoon 3:00PM – 4:30PM or Saturday Morning 8:30 AM to 10:00 AM
- **Cost:** \$885
- **Instructor:** Fitzgerald Driving School

The Drivers Ed course consists of both classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel training. Students will learn important driving laws, safety regulations, and defensive driving techniques. Behind-the-wheel lessons will allow students to practice their driving skills with a certified instructor through the Fitzgerald Driving School. Please note, that a minimum number of students is required to run both a driving or lecture session.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must be at least 16 years old by February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026.
- Students must have a valid NYS Learners Permit with ID.

To register your child for the Drivers Ed program, please complete & submit the online registration form to the Office of Student Services by Monday January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026. The form must be signed by both the student and a parent/guardian and all necessary documentation and payment must be provided in order to register and secure a spot. Driving session times will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Spot will not be held, if all documentation and payment is not received. We have a limited number of 40 spots available for the Spring Session.
