When you have finished reading, create a Google Slides presentation that includes the following information. Please be sure to carefully follow the directions and put the correct information on each slide. Your completed project should include 10 slides total.

Slide 1- Title of Book, Author of Book, Your Name, Date

Slide 2-Introduce Yourself

A recent picture of you and your family

Tell a little bit about the people in your family/who lives in your house

Slide 3- Your School History

Where did you go to school last year? What did you like about that school? What didn't you like about that school?

Slide 4- School History Part 2

What is your favorite subject in school? Why is it your favorite subject?
What is your least favorite subject in school? Why is it your least favorite subject?
Why did you choose to come to SJB? *Please note: Lunch does not count as a subject.*

Slide 5- Your Hobbies/Interests

Tell about at least two things you like to do in your free time and/or things that you are interested in. *Please note: sleeping does not count as a hobby.*

Slide 6- Adjective to Describe Carlo Acutis

Choose one adjective that you would use to describe Carlo Acutis. Explain why you chose this adjective using specific references to the book. If you are going to quote directly from the book, be sure to include the page number where you found the quote.

For example: "As a candidate for canonization who died in the twenty-first century, Carlo was among the first whose online correspondence could have been considered in the investigatory process, both at the local level and by the Vatican (page 125)."
