- A. <u>Online Presence</u>- Describe Carlos' use of and relationship to the Internet. Give specific examples of things he created and how he used this medium for good or evil. Think about your own Online activity; explain how your usage compares to Carlos' or how he could influence your Online choices. (20 points)
- B. <u>Character</u> The book provides many examples of Carlos' Character including information about his being a good friend, helpful to classmates, a willing volunteer, helping the poor and homeless, being a "Pro-Life Warrior", etc. Choose two examples from the book and explain, with specific examples, Carlos lived out these traits in his life.
