You will choose 4 Tuesday’s that Mitch spent with Morrie. Your response should be one paragraph for each Tuesday and include the following:

- **State the subject of your chosen Tuesday**
- **State the intended audience for the book as a whole**
- **Choose THREE words that stand out to you in the passage**
- **State Morrie’s claim in your chosen Tuesday.**
- **Give ONE piece of evidence that supports the claim**
- **Give Commentary on how the evidence supports Morrie’s claim.**
- **Give your opinion: was the claim and evidence Morrie used effective or not effective. A simple yes or no will not be accepted. Be sure to support your reasoning.**
