Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am convinced that our lives and the salvation of the world involves accepting Christ into our lives and bringing Him into our world through our ordinary daily routine. An important part of every person's routine should be meditation and contemplation on the person of Jesus Christ. As Pope St. John Paul II wrote in his encyclical on *The Rosary of the Virgin Mary*, no. 1, "Though clearly Marian in character, the Rosary is at heart a Christocentric prayer." Every Rosary that is prayed is thoroughly Christ centered. We are given the opportunity to meditate on the Mysteries of the Rosary and encounter Christ through Mary's motherly intercession and immaculate heart. A "mystery" of the Rosary is categorized into 5 sets of Mysteries, namely *Sorrowful, Joyful, Luminous, and Glorious*. There are certain days in the week that coordinate with one of the sets of mysteries, for example: Tuesdays/Fridays are Sorrowful; Mondays/Saturdays are Joyful; Thursdays are Luminous; Sunday/Wednesdays are Glorious. Fun Fact: Some religious orders pray all 25 mysteries every day seeking to "pray always" and to constantly be meditating on the Lord. Could we pray the Rosary as a family of parishes? Could we dedicate some 15-30 minutes sometime this week to honor Our Lady of the Rosary?

Mary is a Queen Mother who is forever next to the Lord and intercedes for us. Never has anyone who has fled to her protection, or sought her intercession, was left unaided. As Pope St. John Paul II wrote to all of us, "With the Rosary, the Christian people *sit at the school of Mary* and are led to contemplate the beauty on the face of Christ and to experience the depths of His love. Through the Rosary, the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer." How could each of our churches in our family of parishes learn how to "sit at the school of Mary" a little more and contemplate Christ? I remember in college growing in my devotion to our Blessed Mother's role. I remember arriving at Mass about 20 minutes early to pray the Rosary and contemplate with Mary's help the Lord. I would find myself praying a "Scriptural Rosary" where the word of God became my focus. I am always inspired by the people who make this extra time before Mass or daily to pray the Rosary. I myself find the drive between Eaton and Oxford a perfect time for praying a Rosary and meditating on the mysteries of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ask yourself, "When can I pray the Rosary today?" Then, commit to that time as an individual, as a family, or even as a Family of Parishes.
