

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Please pray for me as this afternoon I am going to take the youth group from both Preble County and Oxford areas to New Paris for Snow Tubing. Please pray that all goes well and there is plenty of laughter and hot coffee/chocolate. I'm sure there will be some video evidence of the shenanigans.

I hope you are listening to the recordings of the Beacons of Light updates. They can be found online at our websites. Please take this moment to learn, listen, and ask the Lord to open our hearts to love in a more generous way together as a family of faith united in Christ.

I want you to be aware of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati policies when scheduling our Mass times. We should follow these and work with them to arrive at our best Mass times for our C-1 Family of Parishes.

- 1. The regular Mass schedule may not assume more than two Masses per day per priest. One day is from 12:01 a.m. until 11:59 p.m.
- 2. A regularly scheduled Mass for the Sunday precept must have annual average attendance of at least 50 percent of the church seating capacity. If not, another time and/or location should be chosen in the new schedule or the Mass should be eliminated from the schedule.
- 3. The regular Mass schedule must provide the opportunity for priests to spiritually prepare for and be present to the community after Mass. This means 30 minutes prior to Mass for the priest to prepare and 30 minutes after the Mass for the priest to be present with people. Keep this in mind as these minutes for the priest to be present are in addition to the travel times between our parishes, meaning that the priest leaves after 30 minutes and arrives 30 minutes before Mass.
- 4. There must be a sufficient number of trained and formed liturgical ministers which includes but is not limited to readers, servers, EMHC, music ministers, children's liturgy leader, ushers, sacristans/mass coordinators, and hospitality after Mass. The goal is to appreciate the time and talent of current ministers with a shared rotation. We are especially grateful to our musicians and choral groups and want to be mindful of training more and more musicians at any age and cantors at any age to help lead us in song at Mass. We need to develop a training process for all people, including seasoned veterans and new people from the parish, to be confident in the roles, responsibilities, and tasks of different ministries at Mass.

Mass doesn't just happen without people. Mass is a time for the community to worship together and to share all our gifts and talents for God's glory, to form and encourage a community of faith, so to be sent into our world and preach the Gospel in words and actions that help build up the body of Christ. I express my heartfelt gratitude for many of you who are already involved in some of our liturgical ministries. I hope and pray that with any Mass time change we all might adjust and continue to be a community that worships well together. Praise the Lord! Worship the Lord in spirit and truth full of joy and love for all of God's children.




