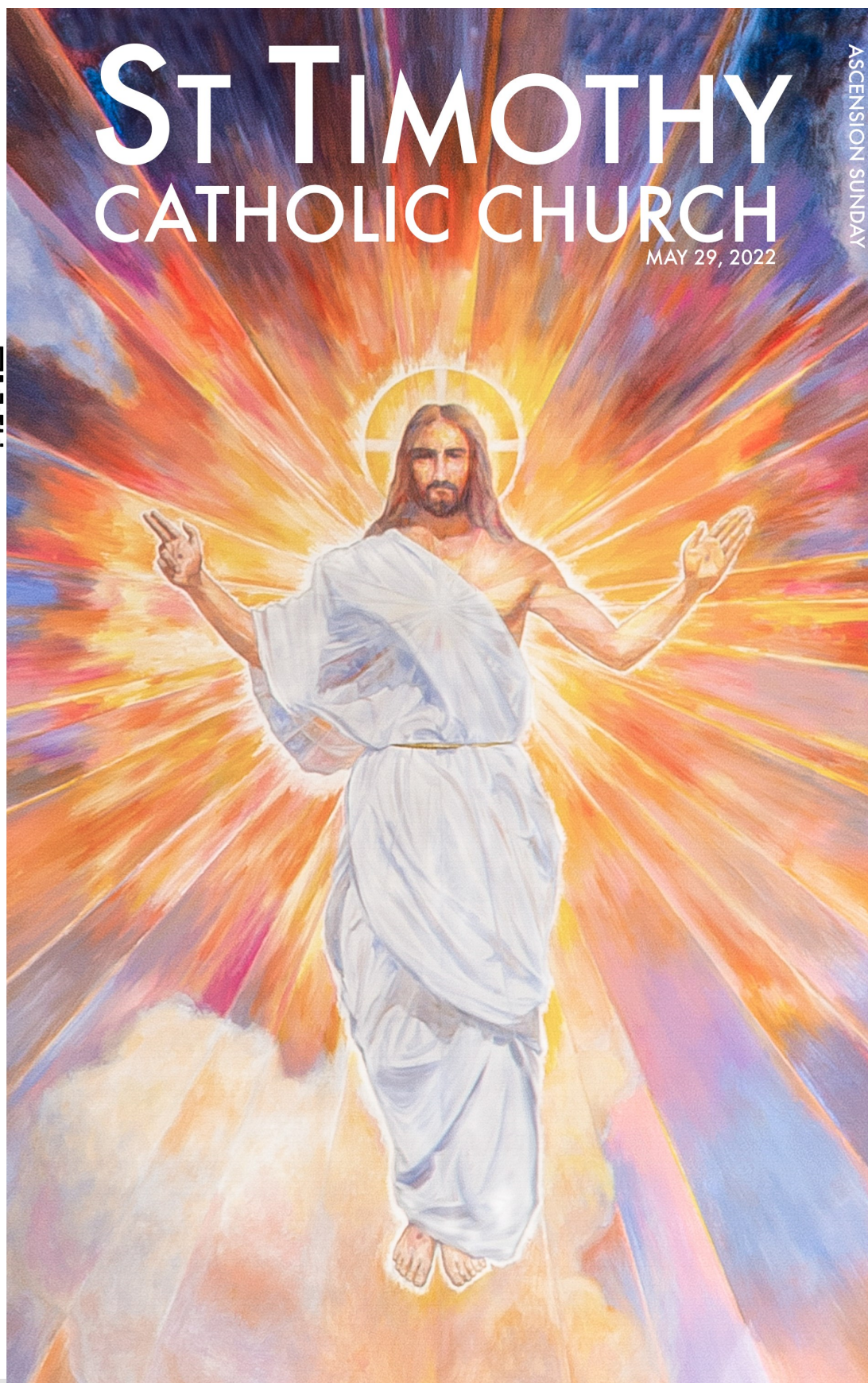

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.

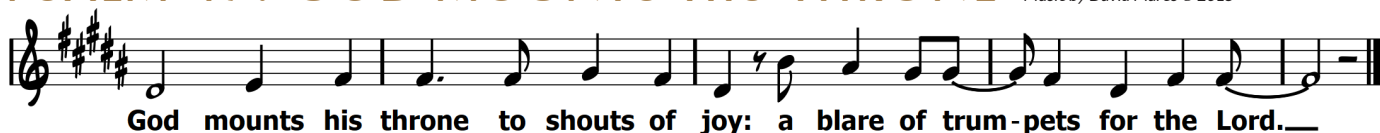
We praise You, we bless You, we adore You, we glorify You,
