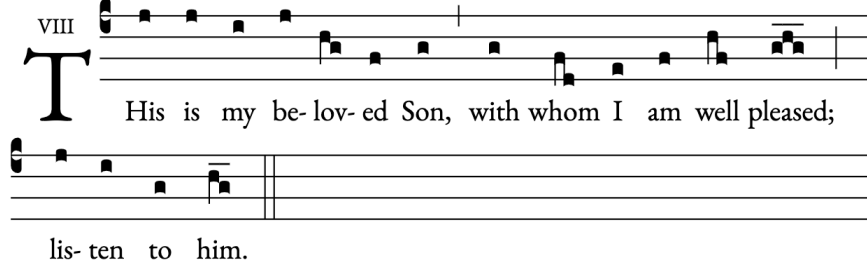
SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

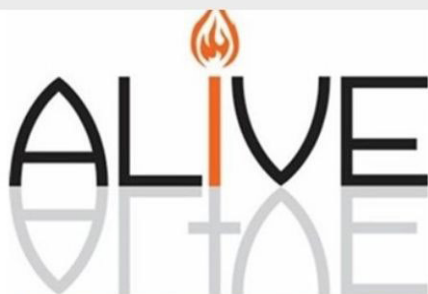

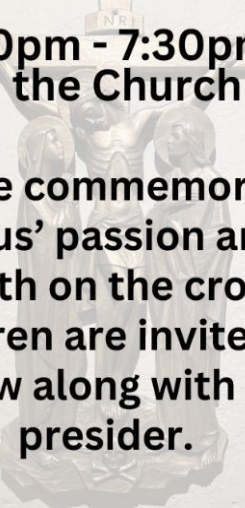

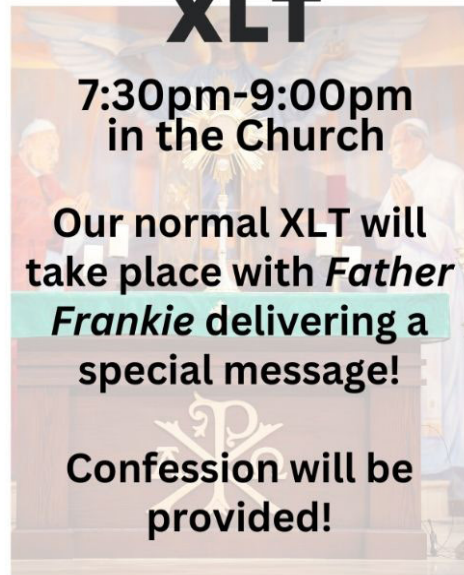
