### **Learning and Living Our Catholic Faith**

#### Jesus Is Calling

"So, when did you know you wanted to become a priest?" It's the hot question when meeting someone new or finally getting a chance to speak with a parishioner in a more casual setting.

The short answer is: when I learned how to pray and saw faithful priests who lived with zeal. I can pin that down to 2003, when I spent the summer attending many daily Masses and starting to attend the high school youth group at the Oblate parish in Hawaiian Gardens, CA, near Los Angeles. The community of my peers gave me something to show up for, and the Oblates fed my mind and soul a seven-course meal of doctrine and spirituality that was anchored in the history of the Church, the lives of the saints, and the reality of our times.

Of course, a vocation to religious life and the service of the Church is not about us wanting it. It is about God calling; it is about God's will for my life, happiness, and fulfillment.



Bottom line: you have to hear God's voice. You have to stay close enough, for long enough, that when you really come face to face with God, He challenges the way you've been living, causes you to decide in that moment that you want to live more for Him than the fleeting pleasures of the world and the enticing lure of fame and power, and so wants you to stop settling for less than awesome, because Jesus already paid the price for

your mistakes and wants you to look beyond this world, at Heaven: the most fulfilling eternity of perfect union with God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a call to ongoing conversion, and a call to perfection - to go ahead and raise the bar higher than you thought you could reach, because He's going to help you aet there.

For me, it was Eucharistic Adoration and the Rosary. Ask around; most of us needed that to seal the deal. But it was because the Oblates of the Virgin Mary had talked about prayer and discernment and wanting to do God's will, over and over, that I was open to it. I had to toss around all the ideas of pursuing careers in software development or cybersecurity, and maintaining my hobby of music on violin, and being involved in community service, and this nagging feeling that God might just want me to serve him totally as a priest and as an Oblate. It was in Adoration that the swirling storm of possibilities settled, and all the options paled in comparison to the one that settled in the middle, right in the depth of my heart, in the peace and silence of prayer in an empty church in the middle of the night: "You're still called to be a priest." And I just knew.

Trust me, you want to do God's will for you. That should be our highest aspiration. It's eminently personal. If you are feeling it, get in touch with a priest or religious brother or sister. If your children are feeling it, reach out to us. We want you to find God's will, not force anyone into a way of life that God is not really calling that person for. It's a great adventure. Jump in.

#### THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

<u>Focus</u>: We are destined to live with God forever, to have the *fullness of joys in {His} presence.* 

The Lord is our inheritance, says today's psalm. He will show us the path to life and the *fullness of joys in {His} presence*. But we know not when that time will come – for each one of us individually, and for the world. So vigilance is the order of the day: preparing ourselves and the world for the great prince of whom Daniel speaks – the coming of the Son of Man who has taken away our sins.

The prophet Daniel speaks of a time when a great prince shall arise, a guardian of the people, and many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake. The Letter to the Hebrews speaks of the one {who} offered one sacrifice for sins, and took his seat forever at the right hand of God. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks to his disciples about the Son of Man's coming after a time of tribulation.

### THE HOLY TRINITY IN THE TEACHING OF THE FAITH THE FORMATION OF THE TRINITARIAN DOGMA

**249.** From the beginning, the revealed truth of the Holy Trinity has been at the very root of the Church's living faith, principally by means of Baptism. It finds its expression in the rule of baptismal faith, formulated in the preaching, catechesis and prayer of the Church. Such formulations are already found in the apostolic writings, such as this salutation taken up in the Eucharistic liturgy: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."81



#### TRAVELING MARY IS BACK!!

#### What is it??

The traveling Mary, Our Lady of Grace statue is a tool to encourage families to come together to pray for vocations and to encourage young people to be open to

the priesthood or religious life. The aim of the traveling Mary statue is to help the parish families become more aware of the need for vocations and of the possibility that God may be calling a member of their family to serve the Church in this way. Vocations become a normal conversation topic in the household, and individuals are able to learn more about the beauty of vocations.



#### **How it Works**

Families sign up to host

Mary, Our Lady of Grace statue for one week (Sunday – Friday), gathering around the statue daily and using the Lanterian Prayer booklet to pray for vocations along with any other prayers of their choosing. The family will be invited forward to pick up the statue after the announcements, just before the final blessing. They will then return the statue to the parish office on the following Friday so it can be passed along to another family within the Sunday masses. If the parish office is closed, please drop the statue off at the rectory.
