Learning and Living Our Catholic Faith

"Nunc Coepimus. We Begin Again."

As parishioners of St. Mary's, you have undoubtedly heard an Oblate Priest quote the words of our Founder, Venerable Bruno Lanteri, "Nunc Coepi - I Begin Again." As a spiritual son of Fr. Lanteri, I propose an alternative to his simple, yet powerful quote: "Nunc Coepimus - We Begin Again."

This summer, I will *Begin Again* as I have been named Vocation Director for the Oblates of the Virgin Mary in the United States. With this new position comes a new move. I will be returning to live in Oblate house of formation at St. Clement's in Boston. However, my appointment as Vocation Director is ultimately a new beginning for both the Oblates and St. Mary's, hence *Nunc Coepimus, We Begin Again*. It's a new beginning for all of us because I now see how small, and limited, and unworthy, I am of this role. I recognize how much assistance I need from both the Holy Spirit and the laity, especially the parishioners of St. Mary's. I need your prayers!

To be honest, I am not good with saying, "Goodbye." You can take the man out of Jerseyville, but not the Jerseyville out of the man. The past two years have been a tremendous blessing. I have been able to live part of my infancy as a Priest literally in "my own backyard." Yet, I have also known for quite some time that Holy Spirit has been leading me towards this new path. Christ has placed a desire in my heart to accompany young men, one-on-one, and help them to echo our Blessed Mother's joyful "Yes" to both the Priesthood and the Oblates of the Virgin Mary and this desire has become aflame.

With this news, some have already asked and more will ask, "What do you need?" As previously written, I need your prayers. Specifically, I invite all of you to pray daily these words to Christ and Fr. Lanteri:

"Loving Father, as Jesus taught us to beg the harvest master to send laborers into his vineyard, so we now ask you to bless the Oblates of the Virgin Mary with new vocations. May your Spirit draw men of integrity to love you intensely, and to serve you courageously in poverty, chastity and obedience. Reveal your mercy to them and remove the distractions and fears that keep them from echoing Mary's joyful Yes. Guide them in discerning the mission for which you created them, so that they will become wise and gentle shepherds of souls. We ask this through the intercession of Venerable Lanteri, and in the name of Jesus the Lord. Amen."

Acts 2:14, 22-33 ~ 1 Peter 1:17-21 ~ Luke 24::13-35

<u>Focus:</u> Salvation through Christ broken and shared was always God's plan.

God sent His only Son, who would save our souls not through silver or gold but by His own Precious Blood. The disciples did not always understand this, as much as Jesus had proclaimed it. The risen Christ broke bread and shared it with them, and they began to truly see and comprehend.

In the first reading, Peter teaches that David foresaw Jesus' resurrection. In the second reading, Peter teaches that we are redeemed by Christ's blood, and that Christ was known before the foundation of the world. In the Gospel, Luke shares the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus who learn from the risen Christ the meaning of His death and resurrection.




