Learning and Living Our Catholic Faith

Can you believe more than Forty Days have passed since Easter?! We hope you are all still celebrating this Easter Joy! Today we celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord!

Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus left His mother and His apostles and ascended to Heaven. Nine days after that (50 days after Easter) God the Holy Spirit descended upon Mother Mary and Apostles who were gathered in prayer in the Upper Room. We call Pentecost the birthday of the Church, because at this point the Apostles, on fire with the Spirit of God, went out and began to publicly proclaim the teachings of Jesus and His Church and baptizing all who came to them. Pentecost, which we celebrate next Sunday is a big deal!

For the 9 days between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost, the Apostles did what Jesus asked them to do: pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. This intense time of prayer for the apostles is called the first novena. "Novena" comes from the Latin word "novem" which means "nine". A novena is nine days (or hours, or weeks, etc.) of intense prayer for a certain purpose. We continue this tradition today whenever we pray with intensity for an intention by praying for 9 days or hours or minutes, etc. Try it!

Prayer for the Seven Gifts of the Holy Ghost

O Lord Jesus Christ, Who, before ascending into heaven did promise to send the Holy Ghost to finish Thy work in the souls of Thine Apostles and Disciples deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to me that He may perfect in my soul the work of Thy grace and Thy love. Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal, the Spirit of Understanding, to enlighten my mind with the light of Your divine truth, the Spirit of Counsel that I may choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven, the Spirit of Fortitude that I may overcome with courage all the



obstacles that oppose my salvation, the Spirit of Knowledge that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the Saints, the Spirit of Piety that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable, the Spirit of Fear of the Lord that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God, and may dread in any way to displease Him. Mark me, dear Lord, with the sign of Thy true disciples and animate me in all things with Thy Spirit. Amen.

7TH SUNDAY OF EASTER – THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Acts 1:1-11 ~ Ephesians 1:17-23 ~ Matthew 28:16-20

Focus: Jesus, lifted to glory, is present to all His disciples in every age.

Today we celebrate the ascension of Christ to His eternal glory at the right hand of the Father. He was lifted up that He might be present to all in every age. As the disciples stood before the Lord on that first Ascension Day, so let us now come before Him with confidence in His forgiveness and mercy, and in the promise that He is with us to the end of the age.

In the opening verses of Acts, Saint Luke describes how Jesus ascended to the Father, having first entrusted His Apostles with the task of spreading the Gospel throughout the whole world. In the second reading, Paul prays that all who hear his words might experience the wisdom and power of the ascended Christ, who now reigns in glory over all creation. Matthew recalls the ascension of Jesus and His promise to be with them to the end of the age.

329 St. Augustine says: "'Angel' is the name of their office, not of their nature. If you seek the name of their nature, it is 'spirit'; if you seek the name of their office, it is 'angel': from what they are, 'spirit', from what they do, 'angel.'" With their whole beings the angels are servants and messengers of God. Because they "always behold the face of my Father who is in heaven" they are the "mighty ones who do his word, hearkening to the voice of his word".

THRIVE BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN

The annual BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN for **ThriVe MetroEast** has begun!! ThriVe MetroEast is a Pro-Life Medical Pregnancy Clinic that aims to be the first choice for women facing an unplanned pregnancy. Their services include:

- medical services related to pregnancy and sexual health
- information, counseling and support to individuals facing an unplanned pregnancy or coping with a past abortion or pregnancy loss
- equipping services to individuals and organizations

The majority of their clients are single between the ages of 20-29. The number of abortion-determined women whom they serve, from 43 different ZIP Codes, has quadrupled in the last 2 years. ThriVe MetroEast's goal is for these women to make ThriVe their first choice before going to an abortion clinic. It costs on average \$1,200 to save one life from abortion. Through the Baby Bottle Campaign, we can help ThriVe help these women and their babies.

The Campaign runs from Mother's Day through Fathers' Day. Please take a baby bottle and return it to the church or parish office by Fathers' Day!






