A little bit about Sister -- Sharon Nolte was born in Golden Eagle, IL. She entered the Sisters of Divine Providence in 1963 and professed her final vows in 1971. She was most influenced to enter religious life by several Sisters she encountered during her childhood, including her grade school teachers.

Sister Sharon earned a bachelor's degree in education from Harris Stowe Teacher's College and a master's degree in education in 1982 from Dayton University. She taught at various Catholic schools in MO, IL, and LA from 1966 -1986. She worked in public relations at St. Elizabeth Medical Center (now Gateway Regional Medical Center) from 1986-88, and was the secretary at St. Joseph Institute for the Deaf from 1989-99. Sister Sharon has also helped coordinate more than 25 religious pilgrimages to Europe. In 2000, she became the secretary and archivist for her Sisters at Providence Center in Bridgeton, MO, and she is now involved in spiritual mentoring and retreats. Self-described as creative and prayerful, she enjoys adapting recipes and caring for plants. Sister Sharon's main focus is Bishop Ketteler's motto: "Cultivate simplicity, the interior spirit and union with God. Strive to please God alone, and to labor for Him alone. He will take care of everything else."

THE 12TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jeremiah 20:10-13 ~ Romans 5:12-15 ~ Matthew 10:26-33

Focus: What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.

Saint Paul tells us that Jesus brings the grace of God as pure gift. And we know that God cares for us so much that He counts the hairs on our heads. Nothing is secret with God – all is finally and perfectly revealed in His Son, Jesus. We ought not fear to share this Good News, acknowledging Christ and announcing the Gospel to the world.

Jeremiah fears turbulent times and impending siege, but also trusts in God. Saint Paul writes to the Romans that sin entered the world through Adam, but redemption through Jesus overflows all the greater to save everyone. In the Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples to fear no one, and that all who acknowledge Him He will acknowledge before the Father.

HEAVEN AND EARTH

333 From the Incarnation to the Ascension, the life of the Word incarnate is surrounded by the adoration and service of angels. When God "brings the firstborn into the world, he says: 'Let all God's angels worship him.'"¹⁹⁶ Their song of praise at the birth of Christ has not ceased resounding in the Church's praise: "Glory to God in the highest!"¹⁹⁷ They protect Jesus in his infancy, serve him in the desert, strengthen him in his agony in the garden, when he could have been saved by them from the hands of his enemies as Israel had been.¹⁹⁸ Again, it is the angels who "evangelize" by proclaiming the Good News of Christ's Incarnation and Resurrection.¹⁹⁹ They will be present at Christ's return, which they will announce, to serve at his judgment.²⁰⁰

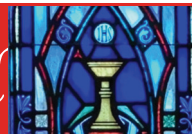

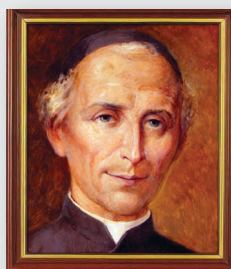

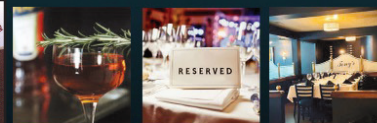
