THE 16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 ~ Romans 8:26-27 Matthew 13:24-43 or 13:24-30

Focus: Jesus encourages us to persevere in faith even in challenging circumstances.

In our daily lives, it can be challenging to persevere in faith, in charity, and in kindness when dealing with people who appear to be the opposite - mean, vengeful, thoughtless. But Jesus reminds us that it is still possible to bear fruit under these conditions, and that even a small seed of faith can yield abundant fruit.

The author of the Book of Wisdom ponders the mystery of God's power, which he exercises with justice and leniency. In the second reading, Paul describes how the Holy Spirit helps us pray. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples about the kingdom of heaven through a series of parables.


The Adoration Chapel will be closed August 7 – 11, and re-open on August 12. Our Oblates will be in Boston during that time for their Provincial Meetings.


