The Fourth Sunday of Lent, also known as Laetare Sunday, is a day of celebration within the more austere period of Lent. While violet is the penetential color of Lent, on this day, the vestments worn by the priest are rose colored, to remind us to rejoice. Laetare Sunday gets its name from the first words of the Introit (traditional Latin entrance) for the Mass of the day, taken from Isaiah 66:10:

Laetare Jerusalem: et conventum facite omnes qui diligitis eam:
gaudete cum laetitia, qui in tristitia fuistis:
ut exsultetis, et satiemini ab uberibus consolationis vestrae.
(Psalm) Laetatus sum in bis, quae dicta sunt mibi:
in domum Domini ibimus. Gloria Patri.

Rejoice, O Jerusalem: and come together all you that love her:
rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow:
that you may exult, and be filled from the breasts of your consolation.
(Psalm) I rejoiced at the things that were said to me:
we shall go into the house of the Lord. Glory be to the Father.

LENT AT ST. MARY'S

Lent is a time to return to the heart of your faith – the Lord! Acknowledge the importance of your relationship with God by the Sacrament of Confession, and say – "I'm sorry." Hear His words, "I forgive you, because I love you!"

REMEMBER DURING LENT:

FAST Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINENCE Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all of the Fridays of Lent.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.




Madison County Catholic Charities Hosts 23rd Help On The Move Annual Fundraiser
