FATHER BRIAN'S DESK

Annual Parish Mission / Triduum of St. Joseph

A number of years ago our parish began an annual tradition of honoring St. Joseph, husband of Mary, with a three day (*triduum*) of prayer culminating on his liturgical feast day – a solemnity observed during the season of Lent. My parish staff, in discussion with me last year, decided that since these beautiful days have become a custom in the parish of Saint Michael the Archangel, we would also make this the time for our annual parish mission – that is, a time for concentrated renewal for the spiritual life of the parish. The annual parish mission will coincide with Lent, already a time for spiritual renewal, and will always in some way be united with our special veneration in the Catholic Church for Saint Joseph, patron of the Universal Church. With his fatherly care and protection, may he assist our parish to serve and adore the Lord as he did, along with his spouse, the Mother of God!



I am pleased to announce that this year the Parish Mission will include homilies offered by priests of the Diocese of Pittsburgh: Fr. Michael Faix, Fr. Kim Shreck and Fr. Tim Deely. Please see the bulletin insert for details, and make plans to enrich your love of God through the model and intercession of Saint Joseph!

On each of the evenings, the Cloak of Saint Joseph will be prayed and all will be invited to be anointed with the blessed oil of Saint Joseph. Many of you know that we are privileged in the patrimony of St. Michael the Archangel Parish to have a relic of the clothing of St. Joseph (with supporting document from the Vatican), which the faithful will also be able to venerate on those three evenings.

Would it not be wonderful to have packed churches on those nights? Let us pray for peace in the world and for matters that are of the utmost importance in our lives – repentance and salvation! Saint Joseph, pray for us!

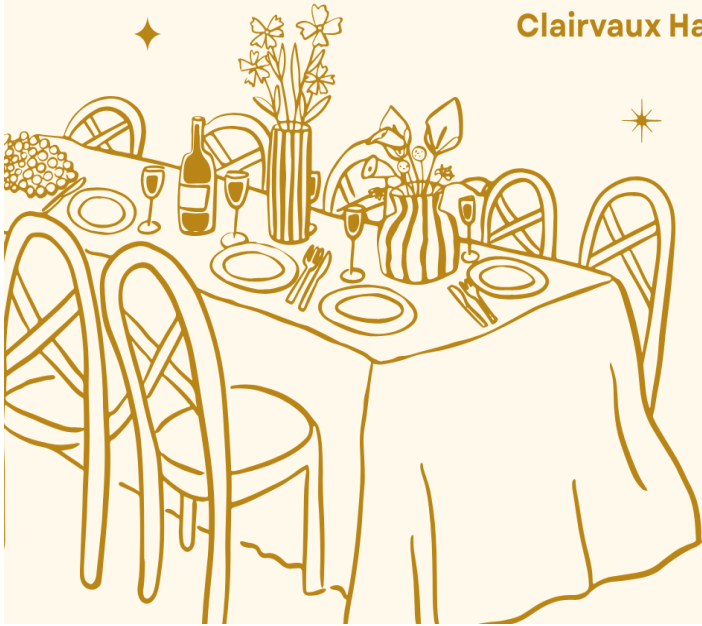

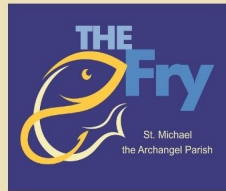

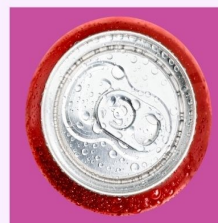
