Passiontide

Last Sunday we celebrated mid-Lent in our Latin Rite with Laetare Sunday, donning rose vestments with the permission of flowers in the sanctuary and the greater playing of the organ to emphasize the coming great celebration of Our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Today, the 5th Sunday of Lent, marks what is traditionally known in the Roman Church as Passion Sunday or the beginning of a two-week period in Lent, including Holy Week, in which we observe in the sacred readings of Holy Mass, a greater intensity of hatred toward Jesus as He nears His Passion.

You will observe in our churches today the "veiling of crucifixes and statues." This "veiling" of our images signifies Jesus hiding the glory of His divinity from His people and literally going into hiding until the events of Palm Sunday when He entered into Jerusalem. (cf: John 8:46-59).

Perhaps this is a good moment to revive our deep sentiments of love for our crucified Savior and we continue to observe a good Lent, and if it hasn't gone so well for us, to re-dedicate ourselves to its faithful and intense observance, leading into a joyful and more worthy celebration of the Paschal season. More than any "observance" during Lent is the goal to be obtained: true repentance and conversion of the heart in which we, Christ's followers, are turned toward Him, ever more refraining from sin, and allowing the transformative grace of Christ to change us and form us into His saints.

Let us also continue to pray a daily rosary, that through the intercession of Our Lady, Queen of Peace, she will bring relief to the discord in the Middle East, bring an end to war and violence, and protect the men and women of our military serving now in that region. If all Catholics incorporated this into daily practice, including families, many miracles would be worked in our land and in the world, as has occurred in so many ways in past history.

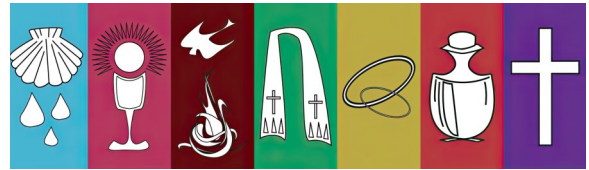
You will be able to schedule your baby's baptism after you have met with Deacon Eric and attended the Baptism Formation Evening.

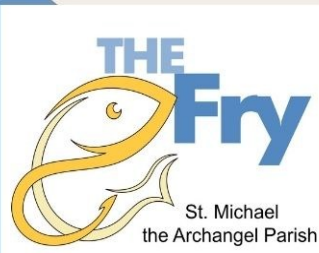

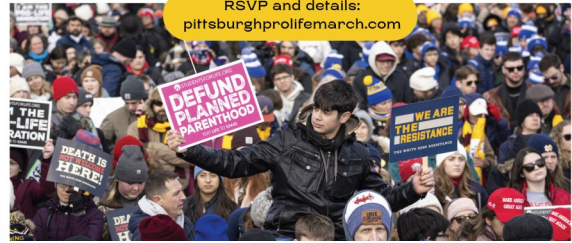
