



Dear St. Mark Parishioners.

This week, we begin the great season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. Thank God for this time of fasting, praying, and giving. These generous offerings and sacrifices allow us to be more like Christ. It is a faithful thing to

acknowledge that our lives are not about us. It is about our participation in God's saving plan. Jesus made many offerings and sacrificed everything to gain salvation for us. Lent reminds us of that and helps us orient our way of life to imitate our Savior.

Ash Wednesday Masses are 6:30am, 8am with the school, and 7pm. It is a day of fasting, which means all ages 18-59 eat one full meal with two smaller meals and nothing in between. It is also a day of abstinence, which means all 14 years and older refrain from eating meat.

Stations of the Cross will be on Fridays at 7pm. Each Monday-Thursday of Lent (starting on Feb 27), there will an additional Mass at 5:30pm. There will be an additional Confession time from 6pm-7pm each Wednesday (starting on Mar I). And don't forget to enjoy delicious fishes at our Fish Fries on Feb 22, Mar I0 and 24, and Apr 7.

Missouri, for a Mass there. You'll be in good hands with Fr. Vitali.





A gesture of repentance, fasting is symbolic of a change of heart as we turn away from sin to live in fidelity to the Gospel.

**Lenten Regulations:** Fast: Ages 18–59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day, with no snacking between meals. Abstinence: Catholics age 14 and older abstain from meat on: Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
